With the park now closed and most of our staff done for the season this past week focused on completing projects and preparing for the wedding that was this weekend.

Park Maintenance

This week with the campground empty, maintenance had the opportunity to do some work around the sites. There were several dead trees that were taken down amongst the B and C campsites. In several of the sites, the taps were leaking so during the week staff temporarily turned off the water to the campground and replaced the taps. Earl also finished working on clearing the deadfall along the path from the boat launch toward the public beach. With the deadfall removed, the area looks much better and will be a nice trail to walk on. This week Earl also spent several days servicing the park equipment and preparing it for winter storage. The majority of the servicing work is done and only a few pieces remain. The remaining equipment will be serviced this week. We also finished reorganizing and cleaning the shop and the area around the shop. The other major project that maintenance spent time working on this week was the retrenching of water lines that were running underneath the roads. The water line that runs towards the horseshoe, as well as the shallow water line that runs towards the back row b cabins, were both re-dug. Hopefully, now that these water lines are moved out from under the roads, we don't have to worry about damaging them when doing road work.

Concessions & Campground

While the park was closed this week, due to the wedding several campsites were occupied and therefore maintenance staff were busy throughout the weekend maintaining the facilities. Overall, from the park's perception, I think that the wedding went well but for future events we should make some adjustments to the event agreement.

End of Season

Next week we will close down the park and continue to prepare for winter. We will deactivate the gates on Wednesday and lock the red gates at that time. I hope to finish the rest of the grant completion report excluding the zoning bylaws next weekend.
