The board has applied for a permit to remove this from the swimming area. Any dock owners that find this to be a problem for themselves will need to apply to the Water Security Agency for a permit to remove the weeds. The Agency will give you permission and directions on how to remove the weeds and the area you can clear.

Please note that we still have issues with under age drivers and you as owners are responsible to ensure that everyone driving your cart must be a minimum of 16 years of age and carry a valid drivers license. Also, please remind all drivers that golf cart use is to get you from point A to point B. Carts driven at night must have headlights and should not be driven after quiet time which is 11:00 p.m. The board requests you report any golf cart violations.

Golf memberships will remain the same for 2015. Please note that a family membership is for 2 adults and 2 children under the age of 18. Extra children will be \$40 for the season. Those family members 18 years and older are required to have their own membership.

It was noted on several occasions people using their gate cards to let friends, relatives etc in the park without paying. Every person visiting a Regional Park must pay entrance fees. If anyone is seen abusing this privilege, your gate card with be de-activated for the season. Please ensure your children are aware of this rule as well. Did you know that you can add your children's stickers to your invoice so that their gate cards are activated May 1st? This will help avoid delays on entrance when the park is busy or after hours as cards are not activated immediately.
