This story reminds us that Jesus came for all people. The magi were not Jewish, but they were still welcomed. They brought gifts and knelt before Jesus. This shows that anyone who seeks the truth can come to Him.

The Epiphany of the Lord is about light shining in the darkness. It shows how God calls people from every place and nation. The magi followed the light, and they found joy. Today, God is inviting us to do the same.
