The Feast of The Holy Family celebrates the love and unity found in the family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. It invites reflection on family life and the values that strengthen these bonds.

And we are reminded that Jesus lived in a real family. He had a mother and a father who cared for Him and protected Him. Mary and Joseph did not have easy lives, but they trusted God and followed His plan. Their home was simple, but it was full of love.



Today's feast also helps us to think about our own families. Every home has struggles. But like the Holy Family, we are called to listen to God and to care for each other with patience. Love grows in quiet moments, hard choices, and daily kindness.

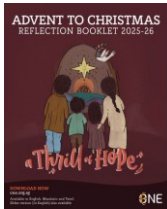

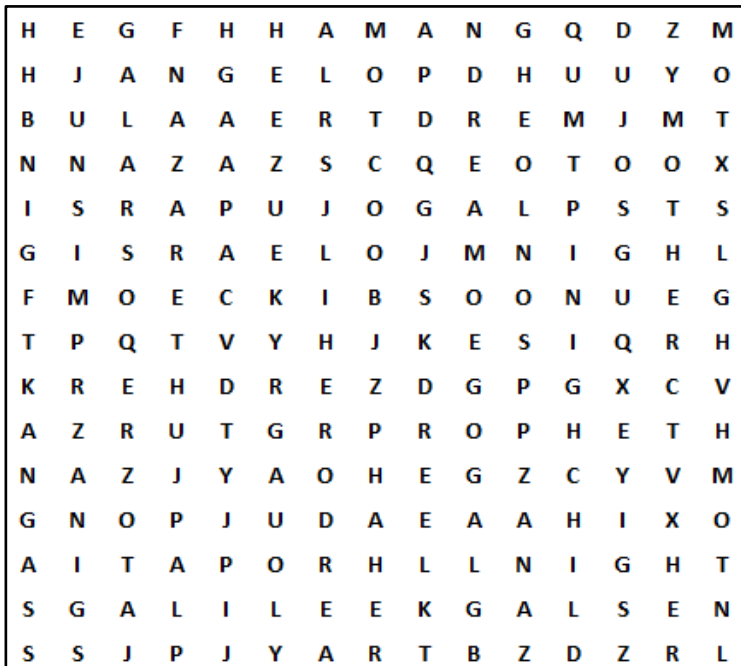
