

Descriptions and Responsibilities for ASQG Elected Board Members

A. PRESIDENT

- a. Is the Chief officer and official spokesperson for ASQG
- b. Presides over all general and board meetings, if possible
- c. Appoints
 - i. Committee chairpersons of standing and special committees
 - ii. Members of to the Nominating committee
- d. Instructs the Secretary regarding the issuance of notice, minutes, and general correspondence
- e. Receives financial reports from the Treasurer
- f. Is a member of the Budget Review Committee
- g. Presents the finalized budget to the Board for approval
- Signs all ASQG checks with the Treasurer being the co-signer.
- i. Signs all ASQG contracts
- Updates the ASQG Welcome Letter annually
- k. Maintains the ASQG calendar in the absence of the Parliamentarian
- I. Performs other duties that pertain to the office of the President

B. VICE – PRESIDENT(S)

- a. Performs such duties as requested by the President
- b. Conducts meetings in the absence or at the request of the President
- Assumes all duties and responsibilities of the President for the remainder of the term in the event the
 President cannot or will not complete their term in office
- d. Is the assistant to the President in all matters
- e. Plans general meeting programs including choosing speakers and contracting for their services
- f. Obtains workshop instructors and contracts for their services
- g. Performs other duties that pertain to the office of the Vice President

C. RECORDING SECRETARY

- Keeps records of minutes including all motions made and carried at each general meeting or special meeting
- b. Prepares minutes of all general meetings and Board meetings for approval.-
- c. Conducts meetings in the absence of the President and Vice President
- d. Performs other duties that pertain to the office of the Secretary

D. CORRESPONDING SECRETARY

- Handles all general ASQG correspondence
- 2. Performs other duties that pertain to the office of Corresponding Secretary

E. TREASURER

- a. Collects all monies
- b. Makes all bank deposits
- c. Pays all bills provided for in the budget or approved by the Board
- d. Keeps financial books
- e. Monthly, submits a report of total revenue, total expense and cash balance to the Board.
- f. Quarterly, submits a report of budget vs. actual expenditures to the Board.
- g. Prepares an end-of-year financial report for the Board and submission to the newsletter editor for distribution
- h. Provides other detailed reports to the Board as requested
- i. Serves on the Budget Review Committee and prepares the finalized budget.





Newsletter Block: Red/White/Black

Due at our March Meeting

White (or white on white): cut 4 pieces

3-1/2" x 3-1/2

Red: cut 4 pieces 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"

Black: cut 8 pieces 2-1/2" x 3-1/2"



Sew one white to one black (4 times) - iron to black

Sew one red to one black (4 times) - iron to black



Sew these pieces together



Then sew the 4 blocks together.
