

### **ELEVATING ETHICAL PRACTICES: NAVIGATING THE** INTERSECTION OF ETHICS, SOCIAL JUSTICE, AND PERSONAL VALUES

Everything we think, feel, and do is influenced by ethics, values, morals, and culture. While we need to discuss the ethics around boundaries, confidentiality, and dual relationships, it is important to discuss the person of the counselor and what they value. What ethics are in the spotlight when working with socially vulnerable populations, organizational and institutional

discrimination, evolving practices, and other social justice conundrums? What about working with a client whose values are polar opposite to the clinician? What about situations where the provider feels personally attacked by the client?
