DAY 1: SATURDAY, FEB. 10

Motorcoach to Minneapolis the afternoon before the early morning departure. We'll overnight near the airport with free time at Mall of America for shopping and dinner.

At only 5.3 square miles this quaint, seaside resort town boasts 3 miles of soft, white, sandy beach, pristine waters, and beautiful sunsets right out your door.

TREASURE ISLAND

We'll be staying at the newly renovated Bilmar Beach Resort for seven glorious nights! You will have your choice of Beachfront Studio or Beachfront Premium Studio rooms all equipped with kitchens or kitchenettes, private balconies, and stunning views of the Gulf of Mexico. The resort boasts two outdoor heated swimming pools, a Whirlpool spa, a state-of-the-art fitness room, pool table, ping pong, assorted outdoor games and outdoor firepits. It is connected to the only beachfront restaurant and bar in Treasure Island, Sloppy Joe's, which is open all day for breakfast, lunch, dinner, and cocktails, and features live entertainment almost every night!

Start your morning off with a cup of coffee from your room or the coffee bar in the hotel lobby. Then take a stroll along the mile-long, paved walkway that runs parallel to the beach. An off-the-menu breakfast is included at Sloppy Joe's every morning at your leisure!

Mid-morning we'll take a trip by motorcoach to the grocery store so you can stock up on snacks, beverages, and lunch items. After putting away your groceries, we'll head over to John's Pass where you can spend a few hours having lunch, strolling on the boardwalk, watching the dolphins and pelicans, and visiting the many shops.

The rest of the afternoon and evening are on your own. Across the street from the resort there is a Surf and Style where you can pick up items you may have forgotten like sunglasses, visors, and sunscreen. There is also a wide variety of beach apparel. A favorite on Monday nights is Ricky T's where Pete and Dean play their guitars and sing everything from Jimmy Buffet and Zac Brown beach songs to rock and roll from the 70's. Covered outdoor dining and delicious food make Ricky T's a great choice for your Monday evening dining and entertainment.

DAY 4: TUESDAY, FEB. 13 (B,L)

TARPON SPRINGS

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast and then meet us for an excursion to Tarpon Springs. You'll enjoy the scenery along our route with views of the water and lovely seaside homes. Greek sponge divers settled in Tarpon Springs in the early 1900's and a Greek community still thrives here. We'll take a sponge diver boat cruise to learn how sponge diving is done and then enjoy a delicious Greek lunch at Yianni's. Then you'll have ample time to stroll along the sponge docks that are now lined with shops. Be sure to visit Hella's Bakery to purchase some out-of-this-world confections that you can take back to the resort and enjoy during the week. The Key Lime Tart is to die for!

DAY 5: WEDNESDAY, FEB. 14  (B)**BILMAR BEACH RESORT**

Valentine's Day is at your leisure. You can stroll along the water, look for seashells, or bask in the sunshine. Lie by the pool, sit in the hot tub, or take a chair out to the beach and enjoy the sunshine and the sounds of the sea birds and lapping waves. Free use of beach chairs, paddleboards, kayaks, and bicycles are included. You might also want to take a ride on the (non-narrated) Suncoast Trolley as far south as St. Pete Beach and as far north as Clearwater Beach. Get on and off the trolley as you wish all for one very low price. John's Pass is one of the Trolley stops and it's there that you can pick up a dolphin watch cruise, or other water rides and attractions.

DAY 6: THURSDAY, FEB. 15 (B,L)**VENICE BEACH**

Enjoy breakfast before we depart for an excursion to Venice Beach, the "Shark Tooth Capital of the World!" Ten million years ago, the state of Florida was submerged under water, and the area was filled with sharks. Over time, as water diminished, the prehistoric sharks died off, leaving their fossilized teeth behind. Bring some sandals today, as we are going to have fun strolling along the beach in search of shark teeth! A delicious lunch will be included at a restaurant on the beach appropriately named, Sharkey's!

This afternoon, we'll be visiting the wonderful John and Mable Ringling Museum of Art in Sarasota. This 66-acre complex features the State Museum of Florida, Circus Museum, Ca' d'Zan Mansion and Bayfront Gardens. In 1927 John Ringling made Sarasota the winter quarters of the Ringling Brothers and Barnum & Bailey Circus. The Museum was established in 1948 and it well documents the rich history of the circus. Be amazed at the art collection that John and Mable amassed as well as at their gorgeous waterfront home!

Back at the resort you will have the evening free to enjoy the nightlife in Treasure Island. Popular on Thursday evenings is Middle Grounds, where a wide variety of martinis and appetizers are offered at a discount. How about a Lemon Drop martini and some coconut crusted fried shrimp?

DAY 7: FRIDAY, FEB. 16 (B,D)**BILMAR BEACH RESORT**

Enjoy your day! Will you be sunning, shelling, or shopping? There is a farmer's market that features everything from pineapples to jewelry only a block away from the hotel so go take a look this morning. You could also book a deep-sea fishing trip for this day!

This evening, our group will take a short walk to enjoy a delicious dinner at Gigi's Italian Restaurant in Treasure Island, a family owned and operated restaurant since 1967.

DAY 8: SATURDAY, FEB. 17 (B)**ST. PETERSBURG**

We'll depart for fabulous downtown St. Petersburg where the Saturday Morning Farmer's Market is a very popular activity for locals and visitors alike. Browse through all the stands that feature a wide variety of gourmet food items, art, crafts, and clothing. Have a seat and enjoy live entertainment and grab lunch at one of the many American-style or ethnic food booths. Take a walk along the waterfront and enjoy the views of the marina with all the beautiful boats. Stroll along the new St. Petersburg Pier that extends into the peaceful waters of Tampa Bay. There's so much to see and do in downtown St. Petersburg!

This evening we will be treated to a sunset cruise complete with beer, wine, lively recorded music and lots of fun! As the sun sets over the Gulf of Mexico, you'll likely be having bittersweet feelings about the close of the day and the end of your wonderful trip in Treasure Island. Maybe you'll just have to tell yourself that you'll be back soon!

DAY 9: SUNDAY, FEB. 18 (B)**AIRPORT TO HOME**

Take an early morning walk on the beach and enjoy breakfast before we head out for the Tampa airport. We'll be taking home with us wonderful memories of our relaxing stay on Treasure Island, and maybe a few shells and some shark teeth!
