Camping Instructions





Where: Very end of Tong Rd. in Gustavus (Google maps will get you to Tong Rd and then follow the plywood signs).

How: Towers Stage is approximately 4 miles from the Airport and Ferry terminal. There is a \$20 daily shuttle, the Wagon Wheel Express which can drop you off at the campsite from either location. Burning Pines has chartered the shuttle for the entirety of July 6th so the schedule that

day may change. There are also taxis in town. Phone numbers are included.

The Campsite: Camping is open to the North and East of the event area. Please be aware this is camping Alaska style. Services are extremely limited. There are outhouses, a fire pit with some cooking grates and cut firewood, a hand well pump for washing etc. (water is drinkable but has a very mineral taste) and a dispenser with potable water. There are sticks on the ground in the newly prepared area so please be careful, especially in the dark. There is no power unless the generators are running. There is one bar of cell service near the log entrance. Internet will be available the day of the event. The Red Rooster in town at 4 corners has free public Wi-Fi.

Tent Camping: Tent camping is located to the North of the event area anywhere past the smaller orange cones. There is a campfire for the campsite (the one surrounded with rocks) and extra wood.

Vehicle Camping: Vehicle camping is located directly to the East of the event site behind the log concert area barrier. Please be careful driving in the vehicle camping area. Some spots may be soft.

What To Bring: Tent, bedding, drinking water, flashlights, bear spray, toilet paper, food, battery phone chargers, chairs, etc. Food will be available to purchase the night of the event only so please be prepared. There will be no alcohol sold at this event so BYOB. Snug Harbor Liquor in Gustavus is open on Friday and Saturday, 3:30-7PM.
