



Match Day Format / Rules + Score Sheet

Line-Up

Away team submits their line-up 48 hours before match day (ensure all players are on original roster and/or DUPR qualifies at time of play)

Home team responds by tournament day.

- Home team chooses whether to serve or receive first.
- Away team chooses which side to start on.
- Switch sides at 6 points.

Match Format

All games are played to 11 win by 2

1 Women's Doubles

1 Men's Doubles

4 Mixed Doubles Games

1. Each player may compete in 2 mixed matches only
2. Coaches determine the line-up (players can stay with the same mixed partner or switch mixed partners)

Total: 6 Games Per Match

Tiebreaker

If the match is tied 3-3:

Dreambreaker

Away team submits line-up first. Home team responds.

Home team chooses serve/receive.

Away team chooses side.

Singles format

Rally scoring

First team to 21 points

Players rotate every 4 points

Team continues rotating in established order

Freeze at 20—must win final point on your serve

Time-Outs

Time-Outs

Each team is permitted one (1) two-minute timeout per match

Automatic Changeover

- Teams switch sides when a team reaches 6 points.
- Serves as an automatic time-out (1-2 minutes max)
