Investigating with our team can sometimes involve large contributions of our time. Investigation days will vary usually on Friday - Sundays depending on if the investigation is indoors/outdoors. Hours can be 3pm to 3am, or even later depending on the distance & size of the location being investigated.

I will be honest there is a lot of hours involved in investigating. For every video camera & audio recorder used there needs to be a proper, unbiased review. For example, if there are 2 video recorders, and 2 audio recorders on a 4-hour long investigation you will need 16 hours to completely review all the evidence collection. This is time that needs to be free of distraction. Review of your material will need to be through and complete with time stamps. We have clients who are often fearful, and who are eager to hear complete results of our investigation. We are not serving clients well if we are not giving them our complete effort. This is the primary reason we insist upon a thorough review of all investigative data.

Investigating can be expensive. Team members are volunteers, rather than paid employees. Costs incurred as a member will be yours to cover personally. Grim Reaper Paranormal does have a stock of investigative equipment to be used on investigations. However, this is team gear, and not gear to be used by individual investigators on a regular basis. You may be assigned a team EMF meter or full-spectrum camera to run for the evening, but you will need to provide your own audio equipment, flashlights, still cameras, and any other personal gear you choose to use in your kit.

You will also be required to purchase a Grim Reaper Paranormal Crew T-shirt for a small price.

Sweatshirts (with/without hood are also available.

Please consider these costs as well as gas, and meals while on investigations.

Investigating the paranormal can be exciting at times, and boring. We spend a good bulk of our time, sitting in dark buildings quietly waiting while our equipment records various forms of data. Often, this is without gaining any valuable data. We do investigate historical sites and public locations, we frequently investigate residential, and commercial clients. Some clients are often scared, and have to build the courage to reach out to us. For this purpose, it is important that we maintain a professional attitude at all times. While I encourage this group to have fun, and be easy going when the work begins a professional attitude is a must. Maturity and compassion are two things that I appreciate in our members, and that I feel is beneficial to the client.

We are a team who operates on the basis of science. This is a group of unbiased, dedicated individuals seeking to obtain evidence using the highest of standard, willing to go the extra mile in order to record evidence. I hate to use the slogan **"The truth is out there"** but the truth is out there.

You might be asking so how is Grim Reaper Paranormal different?

Well, I have high expectations not only of myself as a paranormal investigator/researcher, but also of our group. These expectations are what helps us to be different than the rest.

Please review the following requirements listed below:

- Team members be 18 years of age or older.
- Team members must be free of felony convictions. This is not only for our safety & well-being, but our team and clients.
- Please consider the fact that we must be seen as being credible by our clients. For this reason, I
 insist that our members be drug free, and arrive to investigations free of any prescriptions,
 mind/perception altering substances.
- Team members must be free of mental illness. While this might be seen as discriminatory by some, please understand this is for the protection of all involved. If something disturbing, upsetting, or dangerous happens on an investigation, this can be a catalyst that dramatically affects an otherwise well-managed mental illness. If you fall into this category, please contact me directly so I can see if we have a non-investigative opening that might be more suitable.
- Specific positions with Grim Reaper Paranormal require different skills. We are seeking individuals skilled with computers, and work well with electronics. While it is not required, additional consideration will be given to those with web design/ graphics skills, professional degrees in areas of science and/or psychology, in-depth knowledge in theology, or experienced paranormal researchers.
- If you are currently a member of another Paranormal team, please let me know. This is out of respect for the integrity of your current team, and the management in place there.
