Message from PTSA President

Expectations!

With the unanimous school board vote this week supporting Dr. Brabrand plan for students returning to school for in-person learning, schools are moving from planning to a planning/execution mode, and eventual full execution mode. I've learned over the years that even the best plans are only as good as the moment of execution. Plans need constant refinement; circumstances, assumptions and facts constantly change, forcing adjustments to the plan. Hindsight is always clearer than the future's fog of uncertainty and ambiguity...particularly in these times.

I again ask for grace for our school leadership, administrators, teachers, counselors, support staff...and our students and parents. There will be problems. There will be issues. There will be frustration. There will be concerns. I encourage you to expect them. It will not be a perfect transition back to in-person and remote concurrent education.

What we can rely on is each other and our school staff and leadership. If we are patient, understanding, empathetic and show grace as we all go through this period, we will all be better off...emotionally, mentally and physically. And most importantly, we will be modeling what we want our children to take away from this experience. Let's exemplify with our behavior and actions the values we want in our children. I can guarantee you they are watching and learning. And frankly, I think there is a lot of leading and teaching being done by our youth...the student is often the best teacher.

Computer Science Seminar for Girls 7th - 12th Grades!


Inviting all Girls Grades 7-12! Artificial Intelligence/Cybersecurity Seminar

Recently spotlighted senior, Lidya Demilew, is co-hosting a virtual seminar, tentatively scheduled for March 6 -7th, that exposes middle and high school

girls to computing through two of the fastest growing fields in technology, Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Cybersecurity, and addresses their implications.
