#### Hela Sarana Funded School Projects in Sri Lanka 2019 – 2020


#### School Projects - Florence De Silva Memorial Fund



1. SOS Herman G. School, Piliyandala Electrical installation of the school **Rs 267,400** 

2. Batuwandara Junior School, Piliyandala Repair works of entire electrical installation of the whole school Value – Rs 238,800

3. Sivralumulla Primary School, Nedungamuwa. Gampaha Donated one desk top computer including a screen and a laptop computer with necessary software for both computers Value- RS 174,000





4. Mampe Junior School, Piliyandala

Refurbishment of classrooms including water supply and drainage system. Value – Rs 439,520



## Other projects

1. Hela Sarana donated **Rs 600,000** to complete the centre for the mentally handicapped people at Kobbewela Temple Gampola. The money was raised by Imperial College London Sri Lankan Society



2. Completion of the Dhana Salawa roof at Kantale Mahaweli Viharaya, at a cost of **£4000**

# Hela Sarana Breakfast Programme for the Kidney Dialysis Patients

Over the last 8 years Hela Sarana has been providing breakfast packs and clean water to between 40-45 kidney dialysis patients, every day of the year (apart from Sundays when the dialysis machines are cleaned). Patients from the poorest regions of the North Central Province, travel long distances to get to Anuradhapura Base Hospital in the morning for dialysis. Vast majority of patients are malnourished. For the majority this breakfast provided is perhaps their only meal for the day. Breakfast programme has benefitted and greatly appreciated by every patient.
