Joyeux Noel Celebration Month Begins



The BGHS *Joyeux Noel* celebration month begins with our Thursday December 5 membership meeting at 7 pm; continues with *Les Artisans* Arts and Craft Fair on Saturday December 7 from 9am to 3pm (at Kankakee County Fairgrounds); and concludes with our community Christmas Open House at the Letourneau Home/Museum on Sunday December 15 from 1-4 pm with refreshments served. The chiffonier was built by Alexandre LeMontagne (1830-1918) in 1850 from local walnut trees which he felled, sawed, and planed. This outstanding work of art qualified Mr. LeMontagne as a journeyman woodworker. Those who attend the Christmas Open House can enjoy this elegant artifact and old fashion Christmas tree with gifts displayed, and will have a chance to pick the top BGHS news story/event of the past ten years—three different news events are shown in the final photograph.
