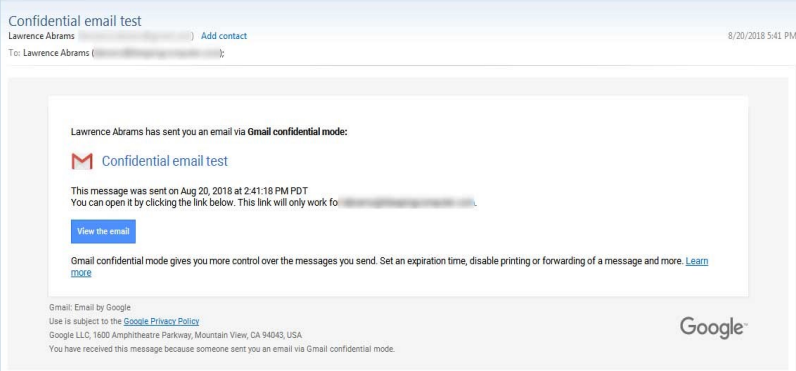

Understanding Confidential Emails

Recently there have been a couple of emails that went out, one to a couple individuals, and one to the entire congregation that used a new feature in Gmail called “Confidential Mode.” This was to make the message more secure during transmission, and to help ensure
