



Understanding Confidential Emails

Recently there have been a couple of emails that went out, one to a couple individuals, and one to the entire congregation that used a new feature in Gmail called "Confidential Mode." This was to make the message more secure during transmission, and to help ensure

that confidential information was not disseminated beyond the congregation. My apologies if this caused you confusion. Typically you will need to have an access code sent to the email address that received the confidential email. If you receive a confidential email in the future it will tell you how long you have to access it, if you are outside of that time or you are having issues with the email please call the office and I will do my best to help you out.
