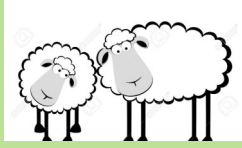

This is not to say that through the practice of daily prayer we earn divine solace and stamina that people who don't pray don't have access to. It's to say that established habits don't desert us in stressful times. And that time spent daily with God results in our gradual growth in faith, trust, wisdom, serenity and joy—which is not dependent on external circumstances. All this is available to one and all at any time. But if we have already been in the habit of daily spiritual exercises, the fall may not feel so far and the climb may not feel so steep. We will have what we might call spiritual stamina.
