## One Shepherd's Thoughts...



Over the last few months, our souls have been battered by pandemics, race riots, economic insecurities and environmental crises. It seems to me that the whole population of the world is suffering from Post-Traumatic Stress Syndrome. Awe and wonder are powerful but little recognized tools to help bring healing in the midst of this trauma. And that is where I feel my focus needs to be—helping people tap into the healing power of awe and wonder.

We all need to discover the wonder of a God who loves us and our world passionately and feels deeply the pain of what is happening. We need to rediscover the joy of living in the world as it is now—not as it was or as we hope it will be—and to learn to rejoice in the beauty of the small and the hidden things, the delight of gasping in awe at the created world through which the glory of God shimmers.

We also need to reconnect to the wonder of a vulnerable God who feels deeply the pain of our world and who often most vividly appears in the outcast, the broken, the marginalized and the abandoned. When our hearts ache—it is God's pain that aches in us. God suffers with us and I am awed by the wonder of this God who is present in inspiring ways in the midst of our lament. I am not sure that my discernment process is over, but I now feel that I have a sense of the next steps and once again it is John O'Donohue who leads me:

"When the heart is ready for a fresh beginning unforeseen things can emerge"

God IS with us!
