



God is Great, All the Time!!








Reading the Psalms and thinking:

"As a deer longs for flowing streams, so my soul longs for you, O God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God." Psalms 42: 1-2a

HOPE Ministry

Micah 6:8, a familiar passage, calls us to do justice, love mercy, and walk humbly with God. We are learning in our Sunday School how to walk with God; worship, prayer, study, and giving are all elements of this ministry. Programs which help people in need are mercy ministries; Meals on Wheels, Family Promise, ECHO, our little bank are all examples of ministries of mercy. Justice involves holding our governments and corporations accountable for fair treatment of God's children. Read Nehemiah for examples of ministries of justice.

At the last meeting, BCC Board voted to join HOPE, Hillsborough Organization for Progress and Equality. This organization has been a formidable force in Hillsborough for effecting change in areas such as obtaining affordable housing and making changes in our criminal justice system. This organization is consistent with BCC's Future Story because it allows us to partner with an existing organization, made up of 22 churches in the Tampa area, which has earned the respect of county, city, and government organizations for their thorough research, persistence, and workable solutions. HOPE is also careful to avoid taking on issues that are political in nature and potentially divisive to churches and their members.

Our annual fee for joining HOPE is \$800 per year, based on our church size. For the first year this fee will be paid for by funds previously provided by the Region for community service. Some BCC members have already provided donations for next year's fee.
