

FEEDING TAMPA BAY



Brandon Christian Church has been serving Meals on Wheels of Greater Brandon since 2002. Along with 16 other area churches, we help provide five (5) meals



per week to over 200 recipients.

Recipients are asked to pay \$2.50 per meal, but no one is denied a meal if they do not pay. All payments and additional donations are reimbursed to the participating churches. While these reimbursements, along with occasional other donations, are the sole funding source for this ministry (it is not supported by the annual budget), the dedication of both church members and some non-members utilize our facilities to provide this service to our community.
