## How To Register Your Horse

Welcome to the New American Tobiano Overo Association. We hope to make this transition as easy as it can get. At this time, we do not offer On-line registration. So please follow the directions and welcome to the ATOA Family.

- ❖ When you register your horse with ATOA he/she become a part of the ATOA family.
- **Solution** Each horse is given their own ATOA Registration number. This number will follow then through there whole life.

**<u>FOALS:</u>** the foal owner registers the foal with ATOA, this might include the Dam owner at the time of foaling. This also might be the person who buys the foal. Your foal must have at least one ATOA registered parent and all breeding report requirements must be on file. When you are ready to submit your forms, please include your photos and payment with forms.

<u>Horses (Stallions & Mares & Geldings):</u> If you choose to register your horse with ATOA you will need to fill out the Membership form and Registration Application for the horse being registered. Remember this application is only for stock and hunter type horses. Submit your application, along with four current high quality, clear images. These should include: right side profile, left side profile, full front, and full rear. Please make sure your horse is clean before taking picture's. This ensures that stains are not misleading. You can send your photos by email along with forms. A new application will be required if any information is changed or incorrect. All requested information, including membership and payment, is required to process application.

#### What will you need:

- Sire's registered name and number
- Dam's registered name and number
  Plus, a signature of the dam owner at time of foaling
- At least two unique name choices for your foal. (we do allow same name if coming from a different Association)
- Foaling date and location
- Sex of foal
- Color, Type, and eye-color details
- If you did not own the dam at time of foaling, fill out the Transfer of Foal section (buyer name, date of sale) and have the dam owner sign that section as the seller.
- **Provide the required photos** please wash your horse prior to taking photos. We require Left, Right, Front and Rear, plus any necessary close ups of minimal markings or traits.
- **Provide additional documents**: if you already have a DNA testing completed from a ATOA approved lab, include copies of those results.
- If your horse has AQHA or APHA, PtHA papers, include a copy of those papers (front and back) with the ATOA registration. These papers can stand in for the signatures required from the sire and dam owners on the ATOA registration application, and gives ATOA the details needed for breeding enrollments, breeding reports and DNA testing already completed.
- Order DNA testing: Starting January 1<sup>st</sup> we will be requiring all horses must be parentage verified for ATOA registration. Parentage verification testing is automatically ordered for the foal. If the dam does not have DNA on file with ATOA, an order will be placed for genetic typing of the dam to facilitate the

complete parentage verification. Order the testing kit for the foal and dam, if her testing isn't already done. You can order additional color/pattern or health testing at this time for the foal, if needed. This is done as part of the registration process.

- You will receive a DNA submission form by email when the registration is processed. Print that out,
  affix a pulled hair sample from the horse's mane or tail, and submit it to the lab for testing.
- **Provide Payment**: Current fees always apply and are based on details like the horse's age at time of submission.

### **FOALS**:

# **Regular Registry or Solid Paint Bred (Paint Parent)**

•	0-90 Days after foaling or June 30 of the calendar year foaled, whichever is later:	\$25
•	July 1 through September 30 of the calendar year foaled:	\$35
•	October 1 through December 31 of the calendar year foaled	\$55
•	Yearling Year & Older: See fee schedule	

### **Non-Paint Parent**

•	0-90 Days after foaling or June 30 of the calendar year foaled, whichever is later:	\$90
•	July 1 through September 30 of the calendar year foaled:	\$100
•	October 1 through December 31 of the calendar year foaled:	\$120
•	Yearling Year & Older:	\$150

## Stallions, Mares, Geldings

- To register as aged Stallion, Mare or Gelding from APHA, AQHA, PtHA registry \$110
- All horse's must be accompanied by one breed registry to be eligible for ATOA

After the DNA parentage verification testing is completed at the lab, ATOA will continue on with final registration
