If you cannot obtain the required signature and/or breeding report from the stallion owner required for foal registration, and you fulfilled all of your breeding obligations to them, submit the following along with your foal registration material and fees:

- 1. Copy of breeder's contract.
- 2. Copy of canceled check(s) showing payment of all breeding fees specified as well as all mare care.
- 3. Breeder's Certificate indemnity agreement completed and signed; a copy of your photo ID can be used in lieu of notarization.
- 4. ATOA will review the submission with appropriate parties and attempt to contact the stallion owner for the missing material.
- 5. NOTE: If the stallion owner advises a dispute exists, then ATOA will not register the foal through this alternative (despite your submission of DNA testing results or other items listed above).
- 6. This alternative primarily applies in situations where the stallion owner cannot be located or will not respond. If there is a dispute of any king, it may not apply
- 7. If this alternative does not apply in your situation, you may have a civil matter that must be resolved through whatever legal means at your disposal
- 8. Your registration application, fees and photographs, if not already submitted, must be sent to ATOA
