This show is a regular member of the United States Equestrian Federation. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

**CLOSING DATES:** Entries are due by May 31, 2023.

#### **ENTRIES:** Online Entries Only ... at Horseshowsonline.com

New entries (new or different horses) made after May 31, 2023 will incur a one-time late fee of \$75. The person executing the entry is responsible for completing all necessary information pertaining to each entry in accordance with USEF rules. Completed information constitutes an electronic signature and agreement. There will be a \$75 office/services fee for every horse on the show grounds. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason. No numbers will be issued without an open check or valid credit card information. Horses, on the grounds, not entered in any classes, must have a completed entry blank in the office and will be charged a \$100 non-showing fee per week. Horses not accruing a minimum of \$100 in entry fees may be charged the non-showing fee in lieu of entry fees.

Once a horse has competed in the first class of a National "A" rated hunter section, the division entry fee cannot be refunded.

<u>CREDIT CARDS</u>: We accept American Express, Discover Card, MasterCard & Visa with a 3% convenience charge. The signature on the entry form authorizes Blue Ribbon Horse Shows, LLC to charge accrued fees. You MUST have your credit card present at checkout or there will be a \$10 handling fee.

**SETTLEMENT OF ACCOUNTS:** All show accounts must be closed out at the end of each week. All questions about show accounts must be addressed within 48 hours of the conclusion of the show. Any mistakes or questions regarding your horse show account and/or prize money must be resolved within 48 hours by contacting the Horse Show Office.

**RETURNED CHECKS:** \$50 will be charged for all returned checks. Accounts will be given 5 days to pay with certified funds or be reported to the USEF according GR913.

**REFUNDS:** Stall fees cannot be refunded unless a certificate of illness/injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian, or a doctor's note regarding rider illness/injury, is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. Once the show has started, proper notification of the scratch must be made in the office BEFORE the start of the class or classes being scratched. In either case there will be an office processing charge of \$75

**SPLITS:** Trainer splits are due in the horse show office by **Friday at noon**. After that point, the total amount will be billed to the trainer's barn account.

**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS**: USEF RULE GR 845: Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses without proper proof of vaccines will not be permitted to enter the show grounds.

**HEALTH CERTIFICATES/COGGINS TEST**: a Health certificate dated within 21 days of arrival to be presented when entering the show grounds/checking in at the show office. CVI must state the horse(s) has not been treated for an elevated temperature or anything related to herd health in the last 30 days. Horses without a Health certificate will not be permitted to enter the show grounds. Texas law requires that each horse be accompanied by a negative EIA certificate dated within one year. Horses without a negative EIA certificate will not be permitted to enter the show grounds.

**NIGHT WATCH:** All horses occupying a stall, showing and non-showing, will be required to pay a show night watch fee of \$20 per show. This fee is not optional.

**NOMINATING FEE:** Horses competing in all 1.20 meter classes, and above, plus any classes so noted must pay a nominating fee of \$175.

<u>CREDENTIALS</u>: All exhibitors in any pony, pony equitation, junior hunter or amateur section must present their credentials (measurement card or amateur certification) to the show office before their numbers can be released. All horses or ponies without a valid measurement card will be measured at a time and place to be announced.

Anyone without valid membership credentials (USEF/USHJA) will have to:

USHJA: fill out a Show Pass form and will be charged a \$30 non-refundable show pass fee. Amateur exhibitors must present valid Amateur Credentials.

USEF: Non-member participants in the role of riders, drivers, handlers, vaulters, lungers owners, lessees and agents must pay a Show Pass fee. Competitions cannot accept payment for a Show Pass from exhibitors. Show Pass purchases can only be made online on the USEF website by exhibitors.

- \* Non-member participants in the above roles are limited to obtaining no more than one (1) Show Pass per competition year.
- \* To be eligible to participate at Federation Licensed Competitions, all persons acting as coaches or trainers, and legal guardians signing entry blanks as coaches or trainers on behalf of their minors must be Senior Active Members in good standing.
- \* The online Show Pass form is available on the USEF website at <a href="www.usef.org/show-pass">www.usef.org/show-pass</a>. The Show Pass form cannot be completed until a competition start date is within the next 7 days or if the show is currently in progress.

<u>SAFE SPORT:</u> All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

<u>USEF/USHJA FEES</u>: Current USEF rules relating to drugs and medications will be enforced. Each horse entered must pay the \$15.00 USEF Drug/Medication Fee plus an \$8.00 USEF fee. Each horse entered will also be required to pay the USHJA Zone Fee of \$7. (Total \$30.00 USEF/USHJA Fee).

HORSE REGISTRATIONS: All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper, and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Proof of registration must be presented to the Show Secretary before numbers can be released. To be eligible for National, Regional or Zone Horse of the Year Awards, and to enter a USEF Computer Ranking List Class horses must also be registered with the USEF. Exception for USEF Computer Ranking List: Citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation need not have USEF Registration.

**SHARPS DISPOSAL:** Sharps containers will be provided in all barns for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharps instruments. ALL items of this nature MUST be disposed of in the provided containers. NO SHARPS are to be disposed of in any receptacle other than the provided sharps container. Any individual or entity not in compliance will be subject to a \$100 fine per USEF 1210.4

<u>CHANGES</u>: Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

**RINGS/FOOTING:** Jumper Ring is 150'x275'. Hunter 1 is 130'x225'. Hunter 2 is 120'x200'. Riding & Lungeing area is 100'x200'. Footing in all rings is sand composite.

<u>HUNTER PRIZE MONEY</u>: The total amount of hunter prize money being offered is \$30,625 for both week 1 and week 2, with a minimum payout of \$7,000 each week. In 2022, the total amount of prize money offered was \$35,125 for week 1 and \$9,993 was paid out. For week 2, \$35,125 was offered and \$11,459 was paid out.

**STALLS:** Entries completed online by May 31<sup>st</sup> are \$260 with no late fee. Stalls will be available on Tuesday, June 13th. Early Arrival Fee is \$10 extra. Stalls are permanent 10 X 10 box stalls with doors & clay flooring. No stall doors or panels may be removed. Feed, Hay and Shavings are available on the show grounds. Orders must be received by 12:00 pm to be delivered the same day. Clean out fee of \$30 for persons not purchasing bedding. Manure to be disposed of in designated areas. NO MANURE IN TRASH CONTAINERS. NOTE: A \$55 grounds fee charged for all horses not purchasing a stall.

**CAMPERS**: Camper spaces are available at \$250/weekly. Please reserve your space on your entry form.

<u>SCHOOLING</u>: Schooling times will be posted or announced & are subject to change. Hunter Rings will be open for schooling on the day prior to the show. Time permitting, rings may also be open before and/or after the show each day for hacking, times to be posted or announced. No manual poling; no offsets of any type may be used while schooling. Jumping will be permitted, in the rings, at scheduled times and only when medical personnel are on the grounds.

<u>COURSES</u>: Courses will be posted a minimum of one hour prior to each class. In Hunter classes, fences will simulate fences found in the hunt field such as; brush, wall, in & out, Oxer, post and rails, and gates. At management's discretion, a dotted line may be put into effect to restrict the size of the courtesy circle in hunter classes.

<u>JUMP ORDER</u>: A rotating jump order will be established for all classes over fences. Riders or Trainers with conflicts due to having classes in multiple arenas must see the Paddock Masters in the affected rings so that the necessary adjustments can be made.

#### HARD HATS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED.

ATTIRE/HEADGEAR: It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper, and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, both open and restricted (including Hunter Hack), where jumping is required and when mounted anywhere on the show grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. See GR801.2. All riders must be properly attired. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible. See USEF GR801.9.

**SAFETY & WELFARE:** Mileage to the nearest hospital with emergency care and Level 1 Trauma Center is 5 miles

ANIMAL WELFARE: We require that all horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion and should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times, while the horse is on the show grounds, we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse by vigorously enforcing the rules of the USEF which pertain to the welfare of the horse. USEF rules defining policy regarding abuse and use of whips will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of bamboo off-set or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. The well-being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors, or officials. Violators may be subject to penalties pursuant to USEF rules. In the event of an acute and serious injury to or illness of a horse on competition grounds when the owner or trainer of the horse or agent of the owner is not present, after reasonable effort to contact that individual has been made, competition management, in consultation with a licensed equine veterinarian, may authorize the provision of emergency veterinary treatment of the horse. If competition management so authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, competition management and veterinarian are not liable for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims, or actions arising directly or indirectly from the treatment of the horse.

<u>RIBBONS/TROPHIES/CHAMPIONSHIPS</u>: All classes receive a trophy and eight ribbons unless otherwise noted. Model classes will receive half points. Each section with at least 2 over fences and 1 under saddle class will receive a Champion & Reserve award based on points earned. Hunter Champion & Reserve awarded per USEF Subchapter HU-7. Jumper Champion & Reserve to be awarded per USEF JP110.

**PRIZES:** All prize money will be mailed to exhibitors within 30 days after the show. Prize money will be withheld if the recipients Social Security number is not on file. Prize money will be payable to the owner unless written authorization stating otherwise and complete alternate payee information is on file with the show secretary. Prize money to be distributed as follows: 30%, 22%, 15%, 12%, 11%, 10% (Except as noted).

<u>JUMPERS</u>: Ties in jumper classes will jump off for first place only. Ties for all other places will be determined by first round time.

<u>DOGS</u>: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards pursuant to rule GR 301. In addition, loose dogs may be impounded by Animal Control.


OPERATION OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds.

Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

RESPONSIBILITY: Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Extraco Events Center & Blue Ribbon Horse Shows LLC. and its officials against any claims, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of the Exhibitor of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against Extraco Events Center & Blue Ribbon Horse Shows LLC. Management by reason of any such claim, Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action or proceeding by council acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and Extraco Events Center & Blue Ribbon Horse Shows LLC. Management is not responsible for accidents, fire or theft.

#### THJA RECOGNITION

Blue Ribbon Summer Festival I & II Horse Shows are operated in accordance with the current rules of the Texas Hunter and Jumper Association by which they are recognized and rated "A" in 3'3" & 3'6" Performance Hunters; 3', 3'3", 3'6" & 3'9" Green Hunter; 3'3" & 3'6" Amateur Owner; 3'3" & 3'6" Junior Hunter; Pony Hunter, Green Pony Hunter, Children's Pony Hunter, Children's Hunter, Adult Hunter, Low Child Hunter, Low Adult Hunter, JR/AO Jumper, Children's Jumper and Adult Jumper. Points for placing in Junior, Pony, Children's and Adult Equitation and Opportunity Walk/Trot Hunter and Opportunity Cross Rails Hunters will be credited in accordance with the rules of THJA.

#### **MEMBERSHIP & ENTRY AGREEMENTS**

#### **US EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

#### FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of competitions listed herein. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

#### **THJA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT**

THJA members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at competitions recognized by THJA. A person/horse may register with the THJA at a recognized horse show as long as the application(s) and payment accompanies the official horse show results. Registrations may also be completed online with a credit card at the THJA website before the end of the show. 





In accordance with GR1111.4: All members MAY compete for Zone Awards or money in any state contiguous to Zone 7: MS, TN, KY, IA, IL, NE, CO & NM.

#### JUDGING FOR ALL HUNTER SECTIONS:

To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability to count. Horses and Ponies are not required to jog for soundness in the Adult Amateur Hunter, Children's Hunter Horse, and Children's Hunter Pony sections.

#### ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULT AMATEURS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:

To be ridden by exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year and who hold a current USEF Amateur certification. Open to horses and ponies. State rules MAY prohibit entry of ponies.

#### ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN'S SECTIONS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:

To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. State rules MAY prohibit entry of ponies.

#### ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER

Sections offered and requirements: Adult Amateurs – may be split into three (3) sections Cross Entry: Riders: The rider may compete on a different horse or pony at the same competition in any other division or sections for which the rider/horse or pony are eligible. Combinations will be permitted Combining/Dividing Sections: MAY be split into three sections: Adult Amateurs 18-35, Adult Amateurs 36-49, Adult Amateurs 50 & over. If any of the Adult Amateur sections have fewer than six (6) entries, they may, but are not required to combine with other section(s). Horse/Pony: Ponies competing in Children's Hunter Pony may not cross enter into the regular pony section. Horse and Rider Combination: N/A. Fence Height: Small ponies: 2'0" with spreads not to exceed fence height, Medium Ponies: 2'3" with spreads not to exceed fence height, Large Ponies: 2'6" with spreads not to exceed fence height. Combinations will not be permitted Combining/Dividing Sections: The Children's Hunter Pony and the Children's Hunter Horse sections may, but are not required to be combined if there are fewer than four (4) entries in the Children's Hunter Pony and fewer than six (6) in the Children's Hunter Horse section. Children's Hunter Pony may not be combined with Adult Amateur Hunter. Awards: Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: Children's Hunter Pony- Small/Medium, Children's Hunter Pony- Large. Low Children's Jumper horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the High Children's Jumpers at the same competition. Horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered. Fence Height: Low Children's Jumper 1.00m to 1.05m, High Children's Jumper 1.10m to 1.15m. Combining/Dividing Sections: A combined Adult Amateur/Children's Jumper section may be offered, and if entries warrant, may thereafter be split into separate sections. If only one section of the Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper is offered or if the Low and High section are combined, the classes will be conducted at the height appropriate for each section (1.00m- 1.05m for Low and 1.10m- 1.15m for High). Awards: Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section: Low Children's Jumper section, High Children's Jumper section.

Fence Height: Junior Equitation 14 & Under: 3'0" with spreads not to exceed fence height, Junior Equitation 15- 17: 3'6" with spreads not to exceed fence height. Combinations will be permitted. Combining/Dividing Sections: The Equitation sections maybe combined if there are fewer than six (6) entries in a section. Awards: Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: Equitation 14 & Under, Equitation 15-17.
