Exodus 20:3



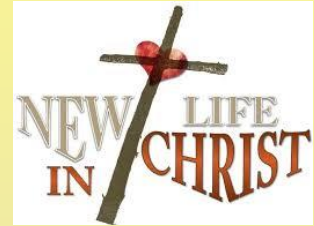
**Thou should have no other gods

can be cast out by deliverance.**

Demons cause men to make idols.)

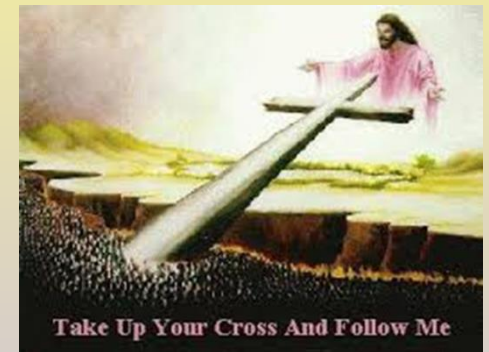
Take up your cross and follow ME. (Take = take up sin to Jesus, cast out demons by His Name and Blood)

Matt. 10:38-39



And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me is not worthy of me.

39 He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life my sake shall find it.



Take up, repent, and cast out your demons and iniquities, = "Cross-wisedness" toward God, to Jesus.

Matt 7:14

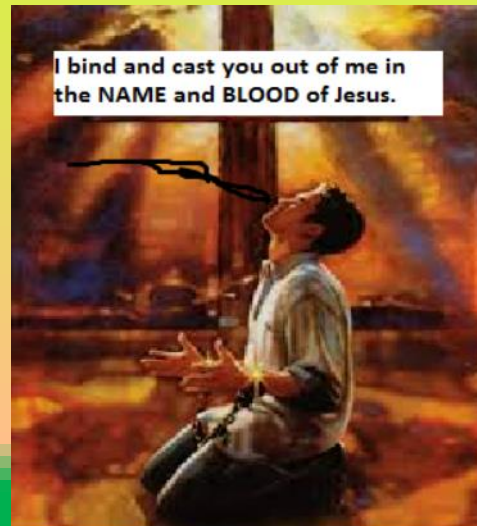
**“Because narrow is the gate

and follow Me.

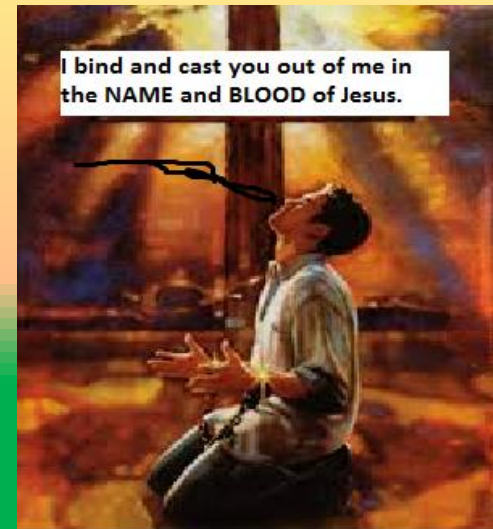


Mark 8:34

When He had called the people to Himself,
with His disciples also, He said to them,

**“Whoever desires to come after Me,
let him deny himself, and take up
his cross, and follow Me.”**

*deny = to give up,
(or cast out),
one's worldly interests,
(idols, and demons)*



Mar 10:21

**Then Jesus, looking at him, loved him,
and said to him,**

**“One thing you lack: Go your way,
sell whatever you have and give to the poor,
and you will have treasure in heaven;
and come, take up the cross, and follow Me.”**

Mat 6:21

**“For where your treasure is,
there your heart will be also.”**



Luke 9:23

Then He said to them all,
“If anyone desires to come after Me,
let him deny himself,
and take up his cross
daily,
and follow Me.”

Luke 14:27

**“And whoever does not bear his cross
and come after Me
cannot be My disciple.”**
