


John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, (Jesus), and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. John 1:3 All things were made by Him; and without Him was not anything made that was made.

You saw that Jesus, His Son, the Word, was with God. God has three parts and each part has a function. God is the Father, and God is the Word, and God is the Holy Spirit, but God the Father is the Head. But they are all ONE.

Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. Genesis 2:16 And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, you shall not eat of it: for in the day that you eat thereof you shall surely die.



Genesis 2:18 And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him. And God made all the animals and none were suitable for a companion with Adam. (And when Adam was asleep God took a rib out of Adam.)

God did not start over with dust to create Adam's help meet. He used Adam's DNA, his rib. Genesis 2:22 And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man. 23 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man. 24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.





Now God said for Adam not to eat of the tree of knowledge of good and evil, but Satan talked to Eve and told her she would not die. So she disobeyed God's word and gave it to Adam and he ate of it and disobeyed God. (They sinned).

## Genesis 3:24


So He drove out the man; and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden Cherubims, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life.


Before, in the garden, they had food, but now they had to grow food for themselves.



Mat 1:18 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit. Mat 1:21 "And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins."





Joseph and Mary went to Jerusalem and Jesus lingered behind and they didn't know where he was, when they found Him, they asked what he was doing in the Temple, Luk 2:49 And He said to them, "Why did you seek Me? Did you not know that I must be about My Father's business?"


Jesus read the Bible and all the stories in the Old Testiment that you read and study. He learned the Hebrew alphabet in Psalms. He knew God was His Father.

Luke 3:21 When all the people were baptized, it came to pass that Jesus also was baptized; and while He prayed, the heaven was opened. 22 And the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and a voice came from heaven which said, "You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased." God the Father sent part of Himself, God the Spirit down upon Jesus, giving Him Power while on earth.



After the Holy Spirit came upon Jesus, He fasted for 40 days in the wilderness, and.... Luk 4:5 Then the devil, taking Him up on a high mountain, showed Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. 6 And the devil said to Him, "All this authority I will give You, and their glory; for this has been delivered to me, and I give it to whomever I wish.

Before Satan was cast to earth, he was Lucifer, a cherubim, in Heaven, and he decided he wanted to be God. God cast him to the earth and when he talked Eve into disobeying God, God said, "You will crawl in the dust of the earth." We have a choice whether we serve Satan and evil or Jesus and good.



7 "Therefore, if You will worship before me, all will be Yours." 8 And Jesus answered and said to him, "Get behind Me, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only you shall serve.' "9 Then he brought Him to Jerusalem, set Him on the pinnacle of the temple, and said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down from here."

And Jesus knowing God would take care of Him said He would not tempt the Lord. He did not obey Satan.




Isa 61:1

Jesus was 30 years old when the Holy Spirit came upon Him, and He began His ministry. He chose disciples who followed Him, and He taught them and preached to the people. He said He came to preach the Kingdom of God.





Mar 1:14 Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the gospel of the Kingdom of God, Mat 12:28 "But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, surely the Kingdom of God has come upon you.

He even taught his disciples to cast out evil spirits in His Name. Jesus had authority over Satan.



Mat 8:16

When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick.

Mar 1:34 Then He healed many who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons; and He did not allow the demons to speak, because they knew Him.

Jesus did many miracles.

Mat 14:19 And he commanded the multitude to sit down on the grass, and took the five loaves, and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed, and broke, and gave the loaves to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.




Jesus taught the people and often spoke in parables.

Mat 13:35

....that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying: "I will open My mouth in parables; I will utter things kept secret from the foundation of the world."

Parables are principles told in stories.



Mat 11:5 "The blind see and the lame walk; the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and the poor have the gospel preached to them.

He said: Mat 6:33 "But seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.



Mar 10:14 and Jesus said to them, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the Kingdom of God.'

He instructed the children to...., Mat 19:19 "'Honor your father and your mother' and, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'"

Children have these two simple commands.



Jesus knew He was leaving His disciples to be with His Father soon, He gave the instructions on what to do.

Luke 22:19 And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me."

Luke 22:20 Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you.

His body stood for the Word of God, and the wine in the cup for His blood which would cleanse them of all sin and iniquity.



Jesus prayed in the garden before He was crucified. This is what He said:

Luke 22:42

....."Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done."

He was our example of love for God the Father. He gave up His will to be obedient. When we are told to do something, this should be our answer.

Mat 27:35aThen they crucified Him, and divided His garments, casting lots, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet:

1Pe 2:24 who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.

Luk 23:34a Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do."

Mar 15:46 Joseph of Arimathea bought fine linen, took Him down, and wrapped Him in the linen. And he laid Him in a tomb which had been hewn out of the rock, and rolled a stone against the door of the tomb. Jhn 20:1 Now on the first day of the week Mary Magdalene went to the tomb early, while it was still dark, and saw that the stone had been taken away from the tomb.

Jhn 20:6 Then Simon Peter came, following him, and went into the tomb; and he saw the linen cloths lying there, Jhn 20:8 Then the other disciple, who came to the tomb first, went in also; and he saw and believed.

John 20:14 Now when she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing there, and did not know that it was Jesus.



15 Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?" She, supposing Him to be the gardener, said to Him, "Sir, if You have carried Him away, tell me where You have laid Him, and I will take Him away."16 Jesus said to her, "Mary!" She turned and said to Him, "Rabboni!" (which is to say, Teacher).:17 Jesus said to her, "Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, 'I am ascending to My Father and your Father, and to My God and your God.' "18 Mary Magdalene came and told the disciples that she had seen the Lord, and that He had spoken these things to her.

Some of the disciples did not believe that Jesus rose from the dead, so He showed them where the nails went in to nail Him to the cross.

John 20:27 Then He said to Thomas, "Reach your finger here, and look at My hands; and reach your hand here, and put it into My side. Do not be unbelieving, but believing."28 And Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!"29 Jesus said to him, "Thomas, because you have seen Me, you have believed. Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."



John 16:7 "Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. 8 "And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: 9 "of sin, because they do not believe in Me; 10 "of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; 11 "of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.



He told them to wait for the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. And they waited and a sound as a rushing mighty wind came and they all had the appearance of fire on their heads and they were filled the with Holy Spirit and spoke in tongues.









Families have different members.

Your dad is the head of the house and leads your family in reading and living the Word of God. In a Christian family, each person asks and receives Jesus in their hearts and seeks to follow Jesus. How do you receive Him in your heart?



Do you believe in your heart that Jesus is the Son of God, died for your sins, and rose from the dead? If the answer is "yes" then say, "I believe that Jesus is the Son of God, died for my sins, and rose from the dead, and I ask you Jesus to come in my heart."

Did He come in? He said He will do what ever you ask if it is according to God's will, and this is God's will for you to be saved and go to Heaven and have eternal life.

Say, "Thank You, Jesus."

Rom 10:9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. Rom 10:10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.



John the Baptist went before Jesus saying to repent and be Baptized in water. Jesus was baptized in water to fulfill all righteousness. All Christians seeking the Lord follow the example and are baptized in water. It is a symbol of dying to sin when you go under the water and coming up is the symbol of newness of Life.

Your parents decide when you are to be baptized in water.


Also, believers ask for and receive the Baptism of the Holy Spirit.



Mark 16:17 "And these signs will follow those who believe: In My Name they will cast out demons, they will speak with new tongues;"

Luke 11:13 "If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!"

Do you remember a good gift that someone gave you? Do you think God would give you a good gift? Would you receive the gift, and use it?



Say, "I ask You Jesus, for the Holy Spirit of Truth to come in my heart and for the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. I receive it by faith and will speak in tongues. Thank You, Jesus."

Now you have received the gift by faith in Jesus and God to give you a good gift. Now you can use it. To use it you may start saying, "Ah, la, lu, yah, so me to sonya. El sanla, so le. (my prayer language), then keep speaking and your language that is different will come out of your mouth. God makes this happen.



This is instruction to the teacher on what to say and do for them to receive:

Now that you have asked Jesus in your heart and received, and asked for the Holy Spirit. Do you believe you will receive?

Do you remember a good gift that your dad gave to you? He gives good gifts. Do you believe that God will give you a good gift? He does. The Holy Spirit is a gift. You don't have to work for it. You do need to open your mouth and let the Holy Spirit use your tongue. You will pray in another language that is the perfect prayer. You don't have to think what to pray. He will answer the prayer you pray because it is Him, the Holy Spirit praying.

Now to loosen your tongue, just try to copy what I say. You really can't, but when you try, your language will start coming out of your mouth. Are you ready?

Now thank and praise God by praying a lot and with your family in the Spirit. When you feel to pray for someone, raise your hands toward them and God and pray and see what God will do. Remember, you are of the Kingdom of God. When we raise your hands to heaven and open your hands you glorify God and receive from Him at the same time.




When you pray in your new prayer language you are putting on the last piece of the armour against the enemy in Eph.6, You pray always in the Spirit. You also serve the Lord because you are speaking the "perfect" prayer. This prayer language is from God and is the Holy Spirit, praying through you. He brings to pass God's will.

If you want to know what you are saying in your prayer language, ask for the gift of interpretation, and He will give it to you so you have understanding also.







Glue the sticks around the type
