

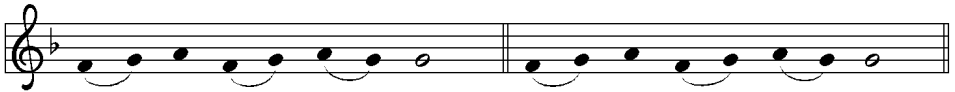



**as we forgive those who trespass against us;**


