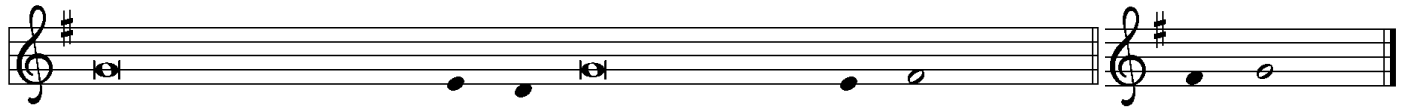


Prayer at the End of the Day for Easter
