MAKING SENSE OF JOHN 17.20-26

(Adapted from Life Application Bible Commentary: John)

<u>Verse 20</u>: Jesus is praying for the disciples and <u>everyone</u> who will come to believe in him through the disciples' writings in the New Testament and their establishing the Christian Church.

Verse 21: In his prayer, Jesus made 3 requests:

- 1) All believers would be united by their similar obedience, love, and commitment to God's will.
- 2) Believers would be unified by each
 +having unity with Jesus and God and by
 +believing God sent Jesus to save the world.
- 3) All would receive Jesus as their Savior.

<u>Verse 22</u>: Jesus completed his mission by revealing God's character to all believers, so:

+God would be real enough for each to share his or her beliefs in God with others and

+Greater unity would evolve from believers having a relationship with Christ in common.

<u>Verse 23</u>: A complete and perfect unity between God and believers results in a worldwide:

+belief stemming from the Holy Spirit inspiring one's witness to others and

+knowledge of God sending Jesus and God loving everyone with the same eternal love God has for Jesus.

Verse 24: We are assured of Jesus' desire for all believers to be:

+with him and see his glory,

+united with him and God now.

+with him for an eternity to enjoy his love for God

<u>Verse 25</u>: Jesus addressed God as Righteous Father in recognition of the tremendous gap between God and the world. Our Savior is the <u>living</u> connection between unbelievers and his just and loving Father.

<u>Verse 26</u>: The disciples recognized God was communicating through Christ, but the world didn't believe God sent Jesus who:

+revealed God to the disciples and us,

+asked God to love the disciples and us with the same love God had for Christ.

8 Points to Ponder:

- If God were to fully answer Jesus' prayer, what would:

 +the worldwide church look like?
 +Zion look like?
 +Zion's witness to the world look like?
 +my witness to the world look like?
- 2) What is Zion's response to Jesus' prayer? What is my response to Jesus' prayer?
- 3) Does knowing Jesus prays for me enable me to be more confident in my sharing Jesus with others?
- 4) Is God real enough for me to seek to share my beliefs about God with others? If not, what would help make God seem more real to me?
- 5) Do I seek the Holy Spirit to empower my witness to others?
- 6) Is my life impacted by my knowing:
 +Jesus wants me to be with him for eternity and
 +God loves me as much as God loves Jesus?
- 7) What can I do through the power of the Holy Spirit to increase my desire and eagerness to narrow the gap between God and unbelievers?
- 8) What else do I want Jesus to reveal to me about God?
