2021 - 2022 STAR Program Qualifications:

- 1. Attend and complete at least 2 safety classes. (eg. High reach, lead awareness, 1st aid/CPR....)
- 2. Attend and complete at least 1 skill set class. (eg. Spray class, faux finishes, caulking, welding....)
- 3. Must have 800 hours working for a contributing employer within the qualification period.
- 4. Must be a member in good standing throughout the qualification period, and dues must be current at time of drawing. (eg. Never more than 3 months behind in dues, no fines, or active charges from the District Council or Local.)
