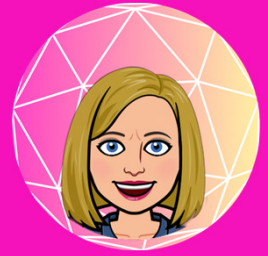
Mouse

Stations can provide time for practice, preview, review, collaboration, choice work time, and small group or individual teacher time.

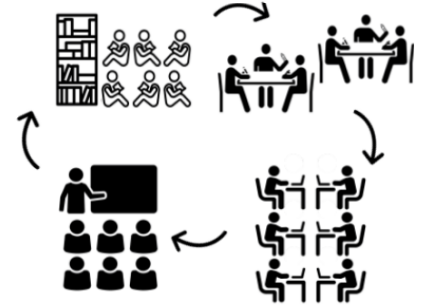

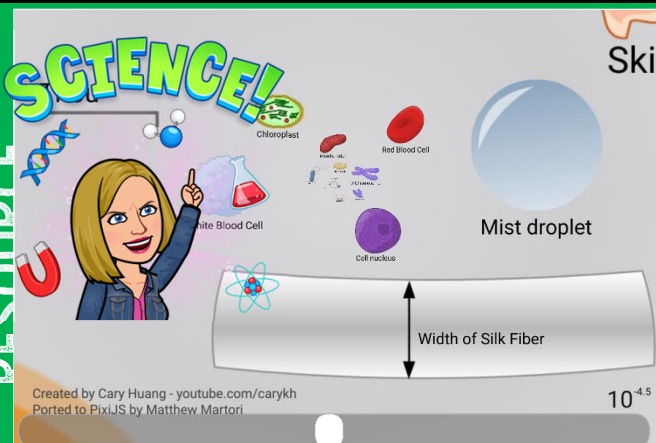
