TICKET DAY:

Picture day this year will be held IN STUDIO on Sunday, May 23rd. All hair & makeup for picture day will be the same as recital - hair in a low bun with part over left eyebrow & makeup listed below. Picture day is not required but highly recommended to attend to make memories that will last a lifetime! All picture orders and questions will be dealt directly through Memory Makers - DANCEintensity cannot assist with these questions/concerns. If you need assistance, please come 5-10min earlier than your allotted time as we will be starting promptly at the time of each photo session. All dancers will be dropped off and picked up at their allotted time. No parents/guardians are allowed to wait in the lobby due to social distancing. If your dancer has a solo and/or duo/trio and you wish for these to be photographed, these will be included in the same session your dancer will be attending. *Masks will be removed for photos but worn while changing and waiting for their picture to be taken.

WHAT TO EXPECT THE DAY OF THE SHOWS:

- 1. Fill out the COVID waiver
- 2. Dancer(s) arrive in their first costume with a coverup and hair, & make up completed, promptly at their arrival time. We have 15 minutes to enter and exit the theatre so please make sure you arrive on time.
- 3. One female parent/guardian will drop off your dancer in the dressing room to check in. There will be staff there upon your arrival to guide you where to go.
- 4. Parents will make their way into the theatre to find their seats and enjoy the show.
- 5. When the show ends, the same female parent/guardian will go back to the dressing room to check out their dancer and collect all their belongings.

COSTUMES:

All information about costumes, shoes, tights, and accessories are in the attached document with the show information. Costumes are being taken home this week!

HAIR:

All hair will be in a low bun with part over the left eyebrow. Please use hair supplies in the same color of your dancer's hair. ALL HAIR ACCESSORIES WILL BE PLACED ON LEFT SIDE OF HEAD CLOSEST TO BUN (if applicable). Watch this <u>tutorial</u> if you need assistance with a bun (donut not required).

MAKEUP:

Lipstick: Rimmel London Kate Moss 107 (if no mask)

Eyelashes: Ardell Glamour Lash – Black 105 (optional)

Eye Shadow: Naked Basics Urban Decay OR a similar palette

Eyeliner: Black - top liner (no wings)

Blush: A color that looks well with skin tone.

Foundation: A color slightly darker than skin tone.

MASKS:

As required by the venue, masks will be worn at all times for all who enter and also while seated in the theatre. Dancers will wear masks while in the dressing rooms & backstage but are allowed to remove them for their performance on stage. If you feel more comfortable to have your dancer continue to wear a mask while performing on stage, one will be provided for them. Please let your check-in staff member know whether your dancer will be wearing a mask on stage or if they are going to perform without one. If you decide to have your dancer perform with no mask, please provide a ziplock bag with your dancers first and last name to hold their mask while they're on stage. Once performers are done with their dance on stage, they will immediately put their mask back on backstage.

COMPANY AUDITIONS:

Auditions for our Season 7 Company Team will be held on Sunday, June 13th! Please fill out the <u>audition form</u> by Friday, May 28th if you wish to have your dancer participate. *If your dancer is currently on our Season 6 Company Team, they are required to audition* A schedule will be released as soon as we have all audition forms.

TROPHY WEEK & SPIRIT WEEK:

We will have a Trophy Week & Spirit Week after recital to celebrate the end of the year! All dancers will receive their Season 6 Trophy in classes during Trophy Week (Monday, June 7 - Saturday, June 12)! Spirit week is our last week of classes (Monday, June 14 - Saturday, June 19) and a chance for everyone to dress up & have fun! Please see attached for the Spirit Week schedule. *No food allowed during spirit week*
