What is a Fast-Growth School District?

To be identified as a fast-growth school district, the following criteria must be met:

- 1. Enrollment of at least 2,500 students during the previous school year; and
- 2. Enrollment growth over the last five years of at least 10%; or
- 3. A net increase of 3,500 or more students.

BACKGROUND

Who led the Bond proposal?

Bond proposal was developed by the Facility Study Steering Committee (FSSC), a 24-member committee comprised of parents, community members, business partners, and TISD educators.



What did the FSSC consider during the making of the Bond proposal?

- Current & projected enrollment
- Growth
- Facilities & facility usage considering growth
- State school funding process & district financial data
- Campus tours

Following months of review, what came next?

- The FSSC presented its recommendations to the TISD Board.
- The TISD Board then called for a November 2, 2021 bond election.

NOVEMBER 2 BOND ELECTION

Community voters will have an opportunity to vote on a \$567,560,000 bond proposal on November 2, 2021.

The bond proposal will be presented to voters in five separate propositions on the ballot.

HOW WILL THIS BOND AFFECT MY TAXES?



If approved by voters, this bond proposal WILL NOT result in an increase in the total tax rate.

- Due to rapid growth in the district and increasing property values (determined by the appraisal district), no tax rate increase would be associated with this bond if approved by voters.
- New state law now requires every school district to include the statement "THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE" on the ballot, regardless of the actual impact on that district's tax rate. Again, if approved by voters, the TISD tax rate would not increase. This is due, in part, to the rapid growth in the community.

UNDERSTANDING THE TAX RATE

Tomball ISD's current M&O rate is \$0.895 and the I&S rate is \$0.355, for a total district tax rate of \$1.25 per \$100 of property value.
