- Empower activists and serve as a deterrent to unconstitutional behavior by law enforcement

National Lawyers Guild Legal Observers[®] are the "eyes and ears" of a legal team. They create documentation during events which can later be use in defense cases, public statements, and litigation which aims to hold law enforcement agencies accountable for the actions of their officers (local, state, federal). No legal training or prior experience is needed.
