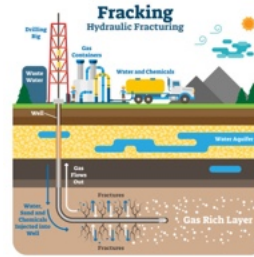

Big Oil and their cronies in the federal government want to frack for oil and gas on property adjacent to Los Osos Middle School, on land just east of Montaña de Oro State Park, and in the Irish Hills just east of the Diablo Canyon nuclear plant.

Caltrans Needs Federal Funds to Operate

California's transportation agency -- Caltrans -- distributes and manages billions of dollars of federal transportation dollars every single year. Every five years, Congress decides how much and what type of projects get funded as part of the "Surface Transportation Reauthorization." Without federal dollars allocated specifically to fund operations, California won't be able to expand accessible, frequent and reliable service that moves people where they need to go. Caltrans put forward a set of draft principles they will send to the U.S. Department of Transportation and California's Congressional Delegation that fails to acknowledge that California transit agencies face a massive fiscal cliff that cannot be filled by local funding, transit fares, and state funding alone.

Sign and send an urgent direct message to Caltrans Director Dina El-Tawansy and California Transportation Secretary Toms Omishakin to include a specific request to fund transit operations.

This Week's Indivisible To-Dos

1. **Call your senators, call your representative, and email them all: They must stop Trump's war!** The Constitution is clear: *Congress* holds the power to declare war. Trump's reckless and unconstitutional Iran escalation has already led to the deaths of six U.S. service members and hundreds of Iranian civilians. Americans didn't ask for this war and we absolutely don't support it. Members of Congress *must* use every lever in their toolbox to put an immediate end to it. Let all your Members of Congress know: We won't accept anything less.
2. **Tell Congress: Halt the ICE terror machine.** GOP lawmakers have been quick to exploit Trump's war as an excuse to insist Democrats drop their opposition to new funding for ICE and Border Patrol. Use our call scripts and email tool to contact your Congressmembers and demand they refuse to expand Trump's capacity to terrorize our communities. Demand serious guardrails be placed on those agencies as a bare minimum for any DHS funding deal.
3. **Register for the ICE Out for Good Funding Fight weekly phonebank.** On Tuesdays at 10:00 am we'll be calling voters in key states to encourage them to call their Congressmembers and urge them to hold the line and demand that ICE's terror tactics be stopped.
