The House of Representatives passed the most extreme voter suppression bill in modern history on Wednesday. **They're coming for our right to vote.** If passed, this and the MEGA bill would:

- Block married women who changed their names from voting unless they get a new birth certificate (that's 8 in 10 married women)
- Eliminate online voter registration in 42 states, forcing everyone to register in person.
- Require a passport or original birth certificate to register —documents that 21 million Americans don't have readily available.
- Threaten volunteer election workers with criminal charges if they make mistakes.
- Create a national database of voters' personal information controlled by Trump.

Resources: What Can I Do?

This Week's Indivisible To-Dos

1. **Join the week of action to halt ICE/Border Patrol terror.** Congress members returned to D.C. yesterday; this will be a critical week in our fight against new ICE and Border Patrol funding without meaningful guardrails and a stop to the violence in our communities. Groups are encouraged to **organize nonviolent rallies** outside congressional offices, and everyone should **use our call and email** tools to keep up the pressure on their Congress members.
2. **Sign up for the ICE Out for Good Funding Fight weekly phonebank.** On Tuesdays (1:00 pm PT), we'll be calling voters in key states to encourage them to call their Congress members and urge them to hold the line and demand that ICE's terror tactics be stopped for good.

3. **Watch the People's State of the Union, TONIGHT (5:00 pm PT).** Instead of watching Trump lie to the Joint Session of Congress, join us and partners MoveOn and MeidasTouch for a livestream of counterprogramming featuring progressive Members of Congress, organizers, and Americans impacted by regime policies.
4. **Join Fight Back with Friends to call on colleges and universities to keep ICE off campus, TONIGHT (3:30pm PT).** We'll review the basics of using ready-to-go messaging and relational organizing to both take action and empower friends and loved ones to get active, too.
