

ARCHITECTURAL DRAFTING

Contest Requirements:

All contestants must provide:

- · Computer, software, and any required hardware licensing apparatus
- PDF WRITING software installed and configured (NOTE: ACROBAT READER DOES NOT WRITE PDF'S)
- USB Flash drive to transport final PDF files for printing
- Contestant MUST know how to use all the above WITHOUT ASSISTANCE.

Upon completion of the allotted time, each contestant will be required to print their drawings for judging. Contestant computers will not be connected to the lab network and will not have wireless access to the printer.

Each contestant will have to use their PDF writing software (e.g., Adobe Acrobat Pro, Adobe Acrobat Distiller, CutePDF, PDF995, etc.) to print their project to a PDF file on the USB drive they bring (See Above). **NOTE**: THAT ADOBE ACROBAT READER DOES NOT WRITEPDF FILES

All software licensing, configuration, and testing must be completed prior to the start of the competition. Contestants should make sure software will operate as needed when not connected to their local network.
