

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ST. PETER NO. 369

BYLAW NO. 1/2025

**A BYLAW RESPECTING PLOUGHING, ENCUMBERING AND OBSTRUCTING
ROADS**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of St. Peter No. 369, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw the expression "road allowance" means any public highway within the municipality as defined by The Department of Highways and Transportation Act, 1997, other than a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such act.
 2. No person shall plough or ditch a road allowance or portion thereof in the municipality except by authority of the Council.
 3. No person shall encumber or obstruct a road allowance in the municipality by having a vehicle, or other article or object standing thereon.
 4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary of conviction to the penalties imposed by the penalty bylaw of the municipality.
3. Bylaw No. 5/2019 is hereby repealed.


