Reverend Marcellus Theron Lee Farmer graduated from Stivers High School for the Performing Arts in Dayton, Ohio, in 2008. At Stivers, he received the “Outstanding Musician” Award from Berklee School of Music in 2008. Reverend Farmer confessed Christ and was baptized at the early age of five at Pleasant Green Missionary Baptist Church in Trotwood, Ohio, where Reverend Dr. Hence C. Coats served as Pastor.

It was at Pleasant Green Missionary Baptist Church that Reverend Farmer received his call to the ministry in 2001 at the age of nine and preached his initial sermon at the age of ten on the subject, “Do You Believe In Jesus Christ, or Do You Just Say You Do,” taken from John 3:16. He was ordained at Pleasant Green Missionary Baptist Church in 2009, at the age of eighteen. It was at Pleasant Green that Reverend Farmer received the foundation of his faith and the map for ministry.

Rev. Farmer has preached for some of Gods greatest pastors across this country. He has assisted in the growth of many great ministries throughout the city of Dayton, serving as a co-pastor and consistent preacher, teacher and motivator on every Sunday service. God has allowed him to learn biblical theology from many great theologians. He preaches the scriptures with an old fashioned, yet current style and delivery is so smooth, you will enjoy his ministry and delivery of style as he praises the Lord.

Rev. Farmer was appointed as the Ohio North Western District Youth President in 2017. He also served as youth pastor of Mt. Enon M.B.C., Dayton, Ohio, that same year. The youth church grew from 5 children to over 200 saved and sanctified youth! He has proven time and time again, through adversities in ministry and in his life, to persevere and continue in the Gospel!
