Call to Worship: But God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world. Galatians 6:14(KJV)

Prayer

Scripture: Galatians 5:13-26 (NIV)

Leader: 13. You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love.

People: 14. For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself."

Leader: 15. If you bite and devour each other, watch out or you will be destroyed by each other.

People: 16. So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.

Leader: 17. For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want.

People: 18. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

Leader: 19. The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery.

People: 20. Idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions.

Leader: 21. And envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.

People: 22. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness.

Leader: 23. Gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

People: 24. Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

Leader: 25. Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.

All Together: 26. Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other. Amen.

Darryl Fairchild is a Dayton leader with over 30 years of service working to improve Dayton. He is an ordained United Methodist minister and is the Manager of Chaplain Services at Dayton Children's Hospital. Additionally, he is a Dayton City Commissioner serving his second term.

As a commissioner he is focused on supporting our young people, promoting good schools that anchor safe neighborhoods, and increasing living wage jobs. Dayton's future depends on all of these building blocks of a healthy community to move forward.

From 2008-2012, he was a community organizer with Lift Greater Dayton, a local affiliate of the Industrial Areas Foundation and a part of Ohio IAF. Lift Greater Dayton organized churches, schools, community centers, and unions to work for justice and a better Greater Dayton. In 2008, Ohio IAF ran the largest non-partisan voter mobilization effort in Ohio. He has served in a variety of ministries including local churches, United Theological Seminary, and as the Executive Director of the Greater Dayton Christian Connections. He has taught as an instructor at the University of Denver and United Theological Seminary.

He is a graduate of United Theological Seminary and the University of Cincinnati, after attending Dunbar High School and graduating from Belmont High School. He also attended the Joint Doctoral Program at the University of Denver and Iliff School of Theology.

A lifelong Dayton resident, Darryl grew up in Belmont and now lives in the Dayton View Triangle neighborhood. He is married to Kim, with whom he has a daughter, Maya. Four cats, Marley, Newton, Midnight and Callie fill out their family. In 1992, he was involved in a bicycle accident that resulted in a fractured back and spinal cord damage that left him paralyzed. He is an avid hand-cyclist and has competed over a dozen Air Force Marathons.
