Letters of Recommendation

Two letters of recommendation are required to submit your application -- a letter from someone in your school and a letter from someone in your community. Use this page to invite your recommenders to upload their letters directly to your scholarship application.

Once you have added in your contributor's first name, last name and email address they will be sent an email. **Please double check that you have typed in their email correctly to ensure they receive the request.

If your recommender does not receive an email from Kaleidoscope, they can also visit: apply.mykaleidoscope.com/login and type in their email address as their username. (This is the email you typed in the email field on your application.) Then, they may use the **forgot password** feature to set up a password. Once they are logged in they will see your application request on their dashboard.

After the nominee submits the request to a recommender, he/she will receive an email notification from **help@kaleidoscope.com** prompting them to upload the letter of recommendation via the Kaleidoscope platform. When the letter has been uploaded, the nominee will receive an acknowledgement email. The recommender will also receive an email confirmation. **Nominees are responsible for ensuring their recommenders submit letters of recommendation by the application deadline.**

Q: I am having trouble uploading my letter of recommendation. Can I submit it directly to the review committee?

Q: How does the scholar-athlete provide the transcript required in the application?

A: Nominees will upload their transcript directly within the Kaleidoscope platform. This is part of **Section 9 – Academics** in the application.
