ORDINANCE #96-03

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING, APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING ENTRY INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, the City of Drakesboro, Kentucky, in Ordinance #94-04, adopted, approved, and authorized entry into an interlocal agreement relating to establishment of a Muhlenberg Municipal Ethics Board; and

WHEREAS, interlocal agreements require the approval of the Kentucky Attorney General, pursuant to KRS 65.260; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Attorney General objected to three provisions in the Interlocal Agreement because of a possible conflict with the open meetings act or the open records act, and objected to one provision in the proposed Interlocal Agreement relating to subpoena type powers in the Muhlenberg Municipal Ethics Board; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement has been redrafted, incorporating amendments which address the Attorney General's concerns.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRAKESBORO, KENTUCKY, as follows:

1. That the amended proposed interlocal agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference as if copied fully at this point, is hereby adopted and approved, and the City of Drakesboro, Kentucky, shall become a party thereto. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the said amended interlocal agreement for and on behalf of the City of Drakesboro, Kentucky.

2. The provisions of numerical paragraphs #2, #3, and #4 of Ordinance #94-04 shall remain in full force and effect.

3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately, it being an emergency ordinance having passed by at least a two-thirds majority. The emergency consists of an immediate need to enter into the amended interlocal agreement so that the Muhlenberg Municipal Ethics Board may be formally created and approved as soon as possible.
