

AN ORDINANCE

The Drakesboro City Council at regular meeting held April 3rd. 1925, does ordain as follows:

That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, company or incorporation in the City of Drakesboro, Kentucky, to own, keep or have in their, his or her possession any dog or dogs, without first paying to the City Clerk of the City of Drakesboro a dog tax as which shall be as follows: For any male dog to any one family or individual a license of one dollar per head, and for each female dog a license of two dollars. Said license to be paid on or before the first day of May each year.

Any person or persons found violating this ordinance shall be fined for each offense not less than two dollars nor more than ten dollars.

AN ORDINANCE

The Council of the City of Drakesboro do ordain as follows: That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, firm or incorporation to build or have built any frame or wooden structure building to be used as business place or residence in the City of Drakesboro fire Zone without first coming before The City Council and obtaining a permit.

Boundary of fire zone to be as follows: Beginning at the L & N Depot and running with road west to west corner of the Black Diamond no. 1 pond, thence in a Southern direction to and including Harlan's Garage, Thence in an Eastern direction to the L. & N. R. R. then with the railroad track to the beginning.
