

**LEGAL NOTICES**

**ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SUPPLY OF WATER AND MEASUREMENT OF WATER PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF DRAKESBORO, KENTUCKY**

WHEREAS, the City of Drakesboro, Kentucky, does provide potable water to its residents which water is measured by a water measuring device at each residence; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of the public health and safety of the citizens of the City of Drakesboro and all those who utilize said water and to insure that all water consumed is properly measured and paid for, this Ordinance is enacted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRAKESBORO, KENTUCKY, as follows:

1. From and after the date of this Ordinance, each household which receives water from the City of Drakesboro, Kentucky, shall have a separate measuring

device which shall measure at the source of supply to said household the quantity of water delivered each month.

2. Household is defined as being any single user of water, to include a business, permanent structure household, mobile home, apartment providing permanent residence for one or more persons, or any other use for a single family, service or facility.

3. No person shall allow to be connected to their metering device, to the service line from the meter to the residence, to the line between the main trunk line and the meter, or to the main trunk line any device or other line which would allow any other person to obtain water which would not be metered separately to that other user.

4. Any person who has found to have violated the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to having their service terminated for having violated this Ordinance, and in addition, shall be subject to all civil and criminal penalties available at

law.

5. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after the date of publication.
