


OUR PROGRAM

The explorers receive training similar to volunteer and professional firefighters, including basic fire chemistry, hose evolutions, ladder operations, medical and CPR training, hazardous materials, and auto extrication. The explorer program is intense and demanding, however the rewards are increased character and the understanding of what it takes to pursue a career in the fire service.

REQUIREMENTS

- 15 Years Old
- Maintain a 2.5 GPA in School
- Must Obtain Valid Working Papers
- Must be in good standing with your school and your community
- A Parent or Guardian who will sign your application and attend your interview





The Explorer program is for teens interested in fire science, emergency medical services (EMS), and emergency management. Fire Explorers will spend time learning about:

- Vehicle Rescue
- Water Rescue
- Fire Prevention Education
