We have big pictures of Lois and Ann - in glass frames. Lois's frame broke. Bonnie wanted to know who we could get new pictures from. We received 8x10 photos to replace the poster sized big pictures. We could replace the broken frame for \$20-\$30. OR we can enlarge the photos (Lyndsey can do this for free). We can replace the glass with acrylic for \$60/picture. Bonnie talked with Val, Janice and the Board who agreed it should be paid for by the District. The raffle at Serenity Weekend earned \$172 for the District.

- August District Meeting (Sunday August 4) District 7 GRs will elect a new District Representative
- Area Fall Assembly (Saturday October 12 Carroll, Iowa) Area GRs will elect new Area officers
  and coordinators. Be sure to arrive on time to be registered, and no one is allowed to leave the
  room when voting occurs
- District Service Workshop (Saturday, November 2) District 7 GRs will elect the remaining officers and chairpersons for the district.

When we don't support assemblies through attending the event, eating the meals, and staying in the reserved hotel rooms, it can become a financial hardship for the organization.
