The Community Foundation of Lincoln County (CFLC) is all about giving back to this area that we love. Now 17 years old, the CFLC supports Lincoln County more and more every year. The CFLC acts as fiscal agent for its Fund Partners, distributing grants on their behalf. The CFLC also gives annual grants to local nonprofit groups, which is the focus of building the **Legacy Fund**.

Accomplishments in the last year:

- Awarded over \$617,000 in Shelter Fund disaster relief grants to McBride Fire victims, thanks to hundreds of donors
- Awarded grants to 13 local nonprofit groups impacting all Lincoln County communities. This included Boys & Girls Club, Food 4 Kids, Carrizozo Music, Corona Library, HEAL/The Nest, High Mountain Youth Project, Hope Harbor, Humane Society of Lincoln County, Lincoln County Food Bank, Santa's Helpers, Ronald McDonald House, Sierra Blanca Book Share Project, and Healing America's Heroes
- Coordinated with our Fund Partners to award scholarships; feed orphans; care for the elderly; promote literacy; empower the disabled; care for seniors, spay and neuter countless cats and dogs, and the list goes on...

The CFLC continues to grow the **Lincoln County Legacy Fund**, a permanent endowment that will never be spent. It is for all of us. The appreciation and income will give grants each year to help qualified nonprofit groups achieve their goals. The focus is *always* local. We have raised so far \$514,000 towards our \$1,000,000 goal - over halfway!
