- If at all possible, please try to avoid traveling on Deer Park or High Mesa and exit out towards Lake Shore Drive or Fort Stanton Road to prevent any traffic problems with incoming emergency vehicles.
- In the event of exits being blocked or you are unsure how to proceed, You are encouraged to muster at the ALGCC Clubhouse.
