## McGrath's Critical Leadership Functions

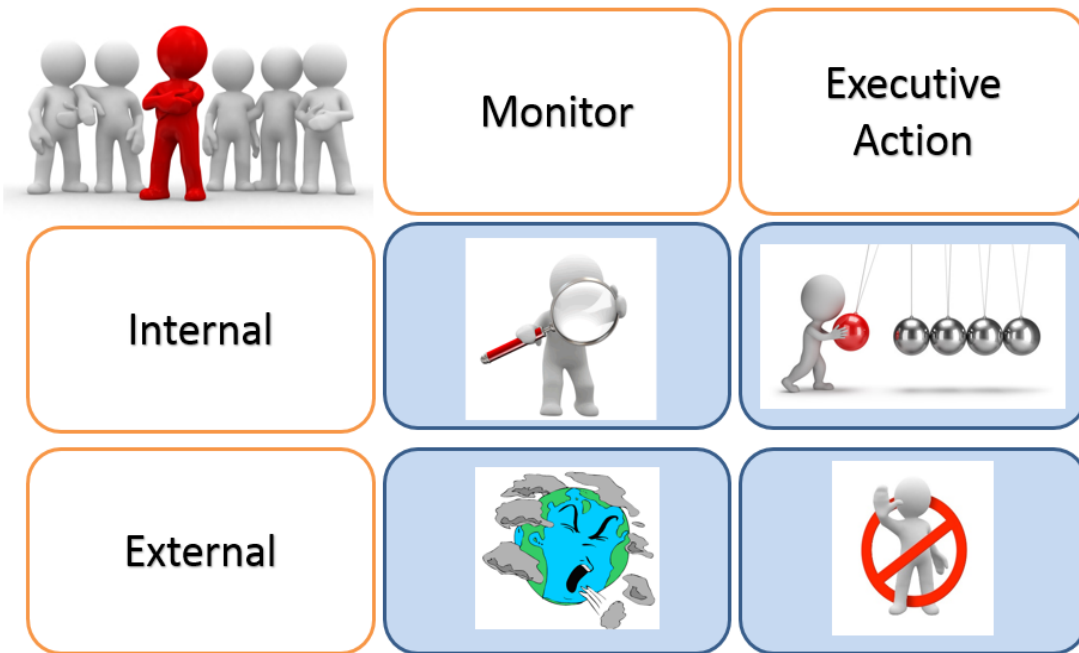
