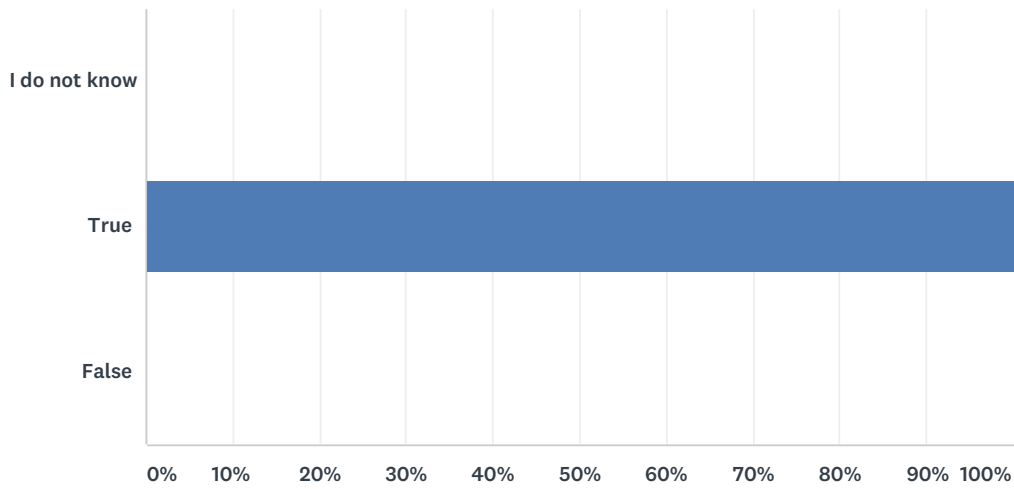

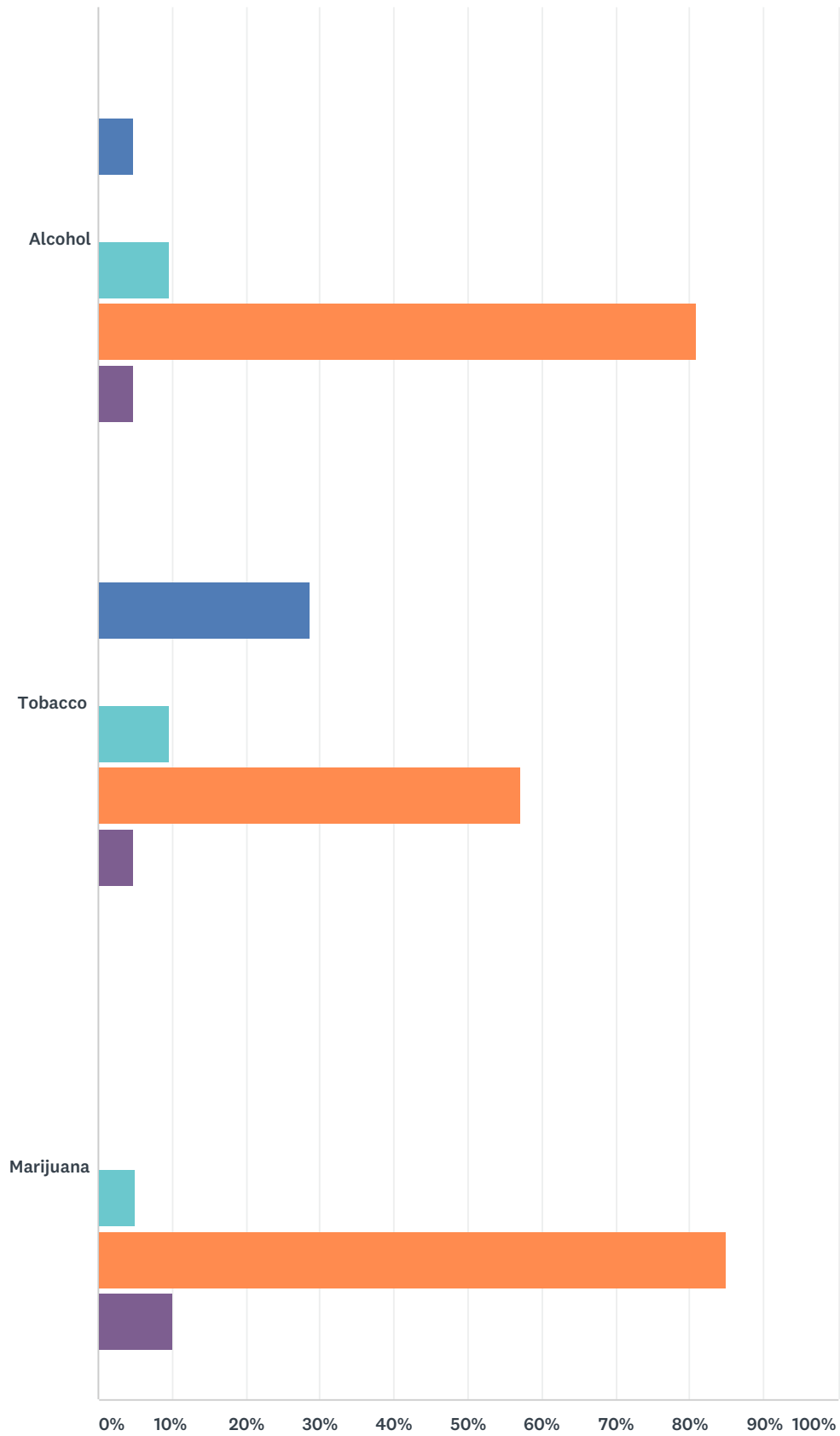

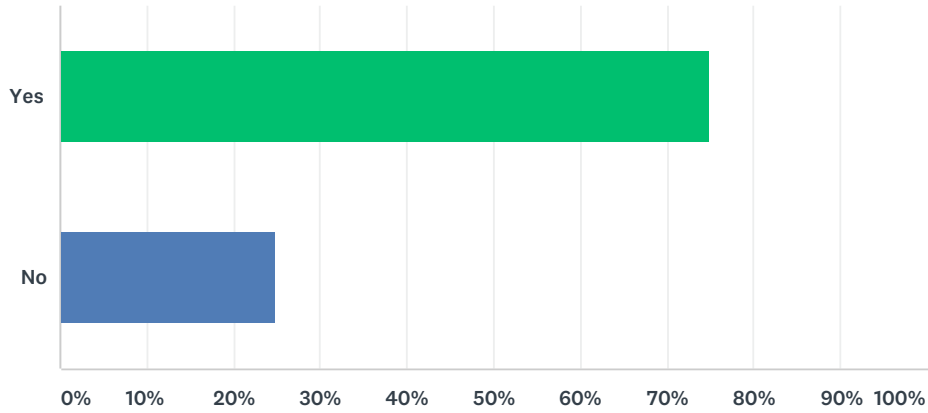

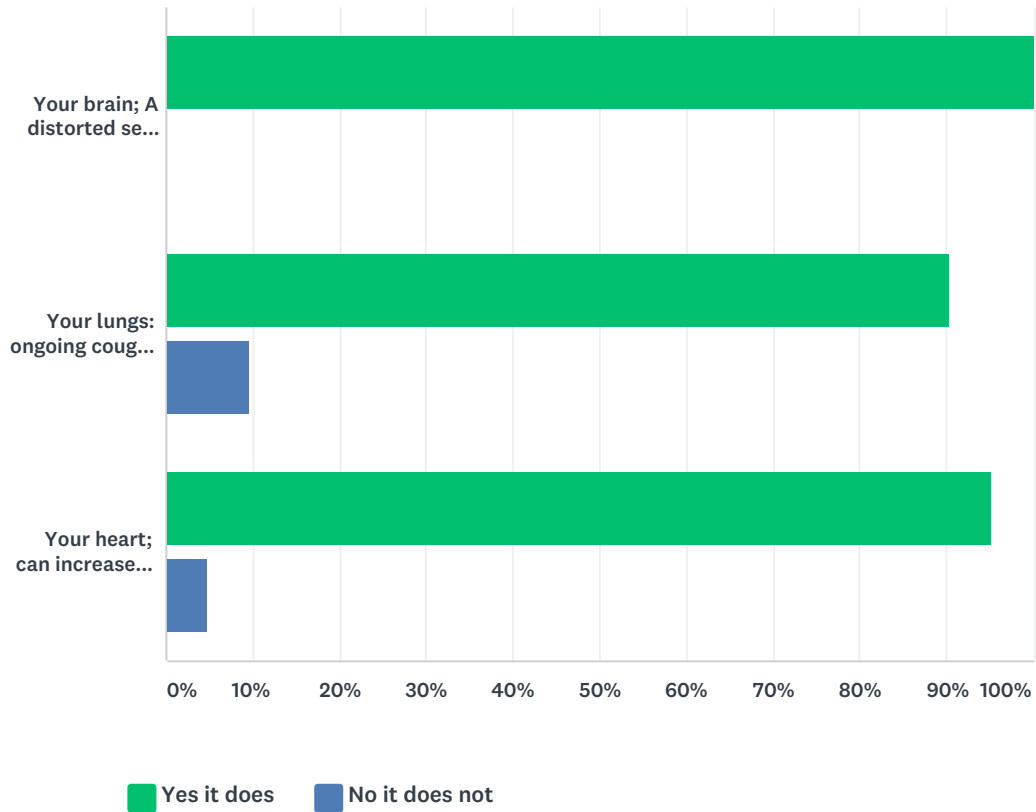

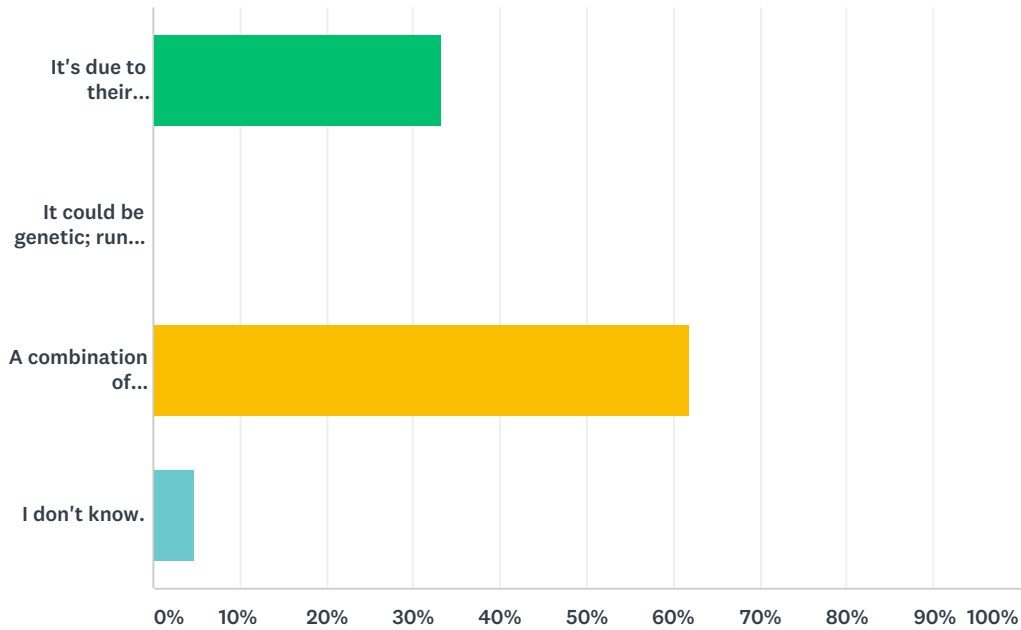

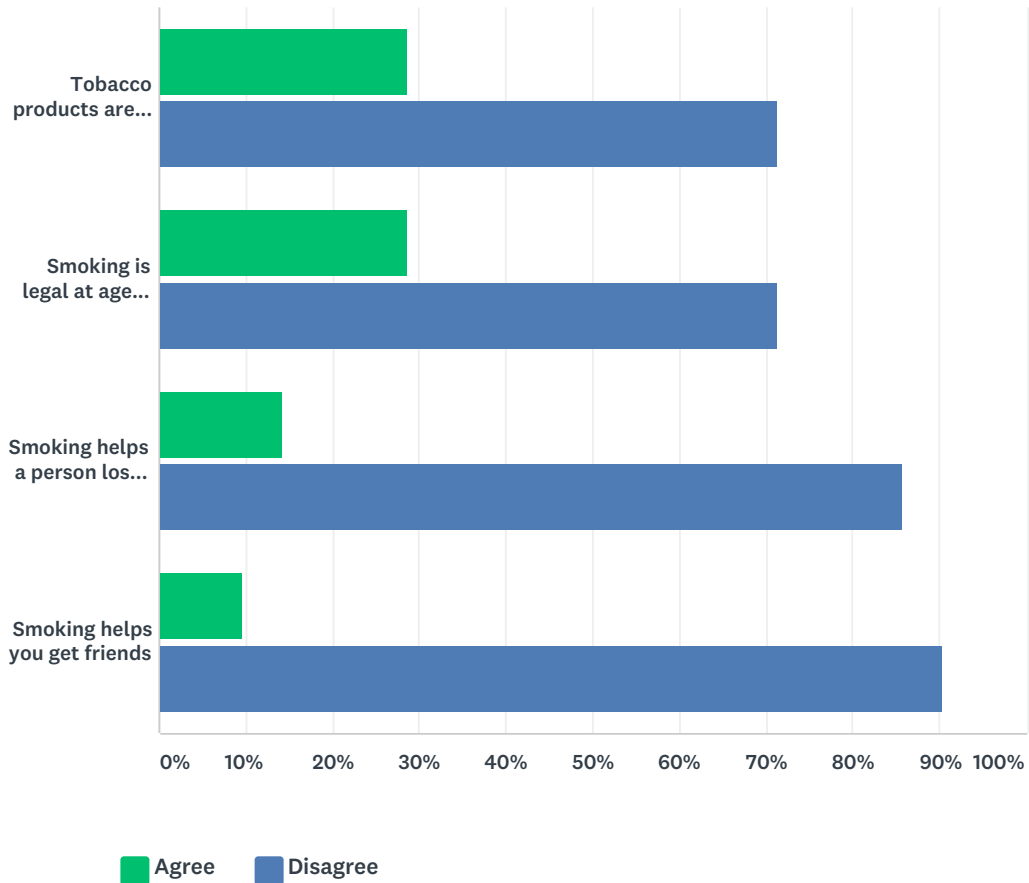

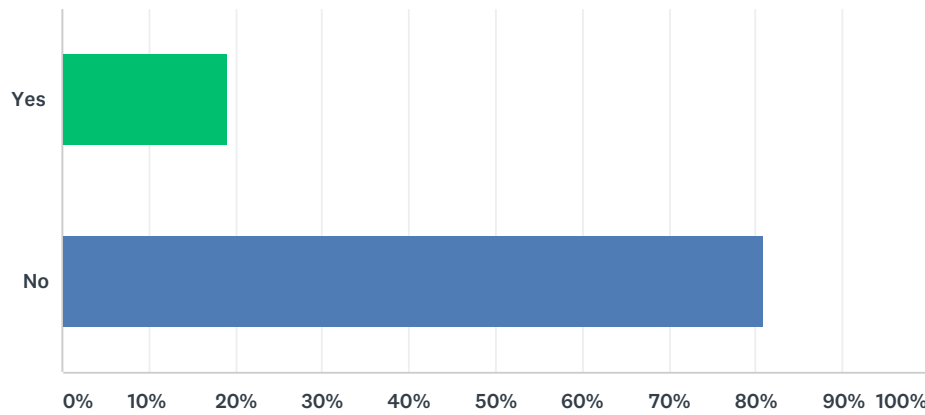

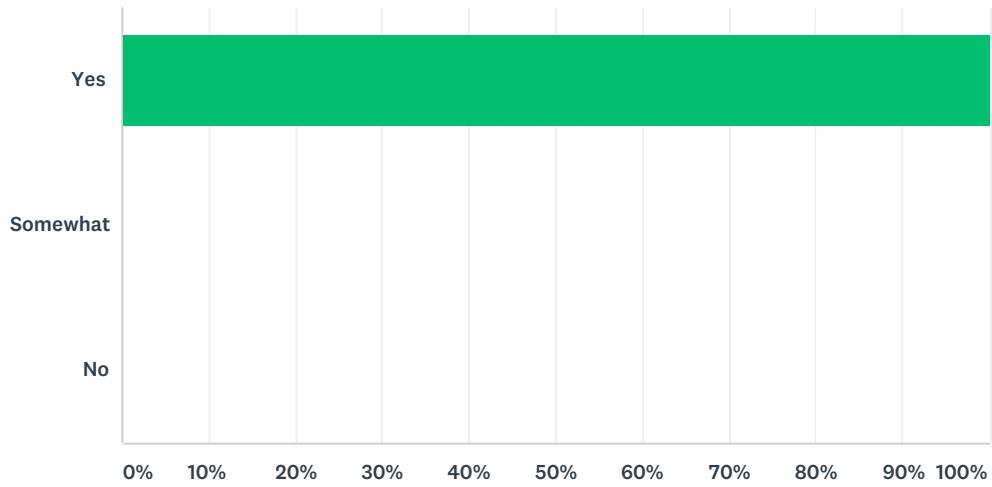

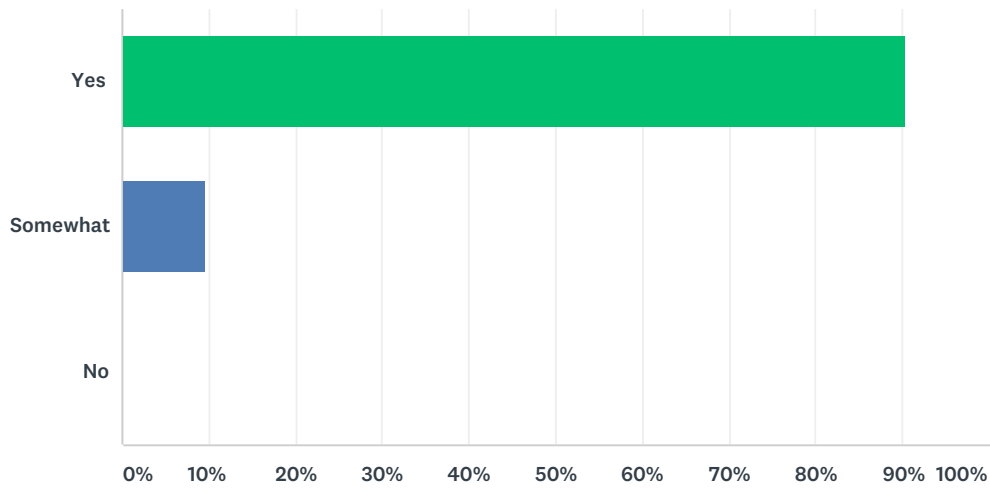

Q13 Do you feel you have a better understanding of what can happen if a person uses drugs or alcohol?

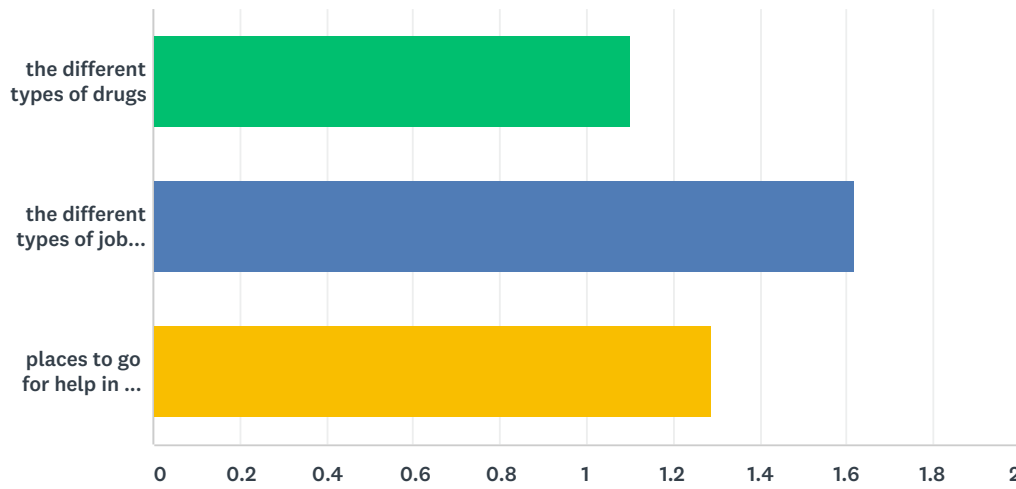

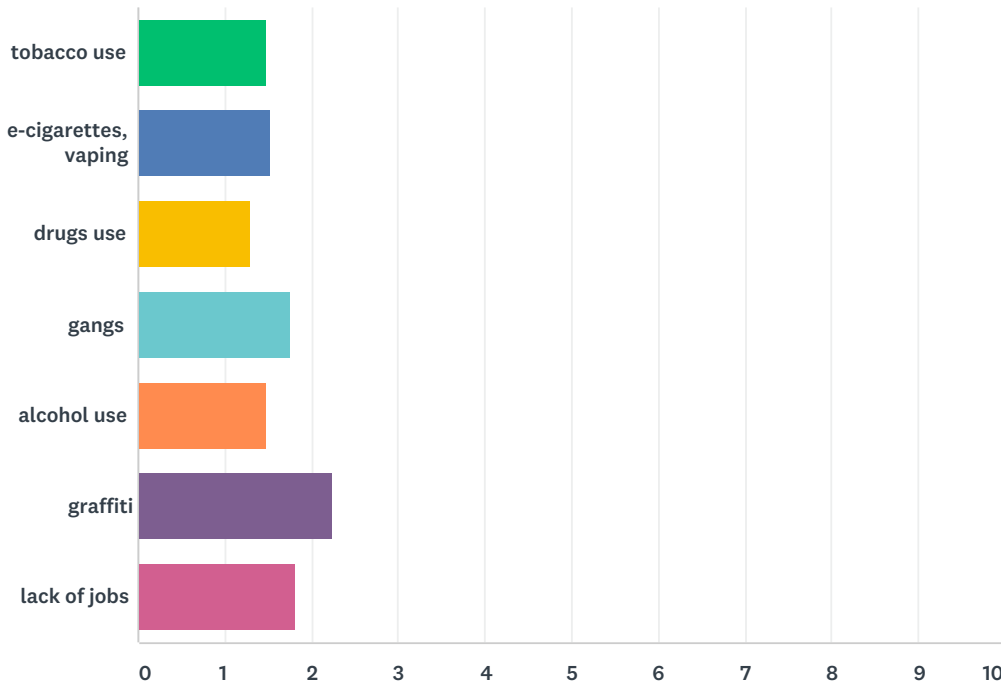

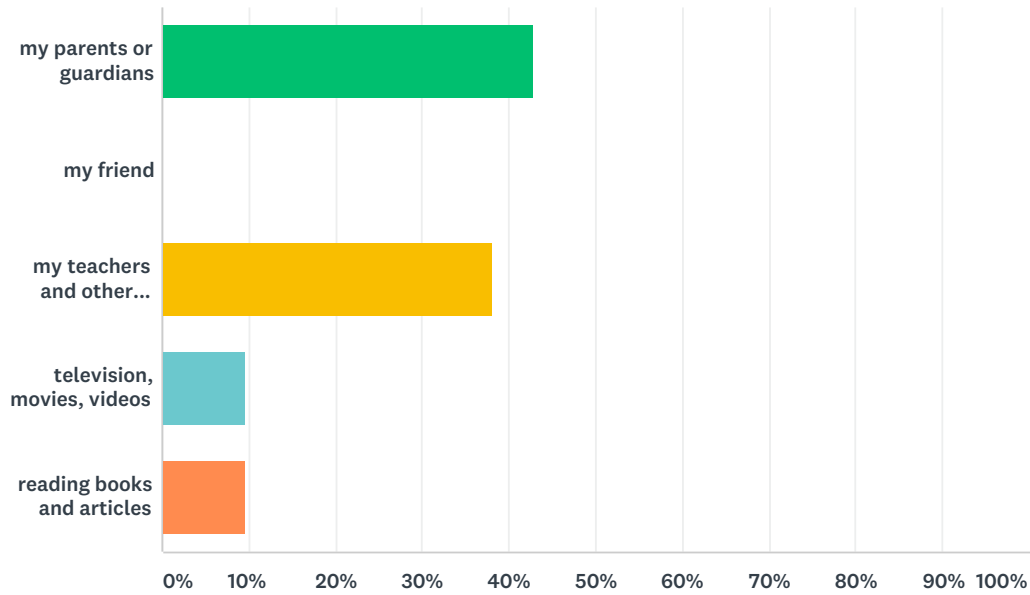

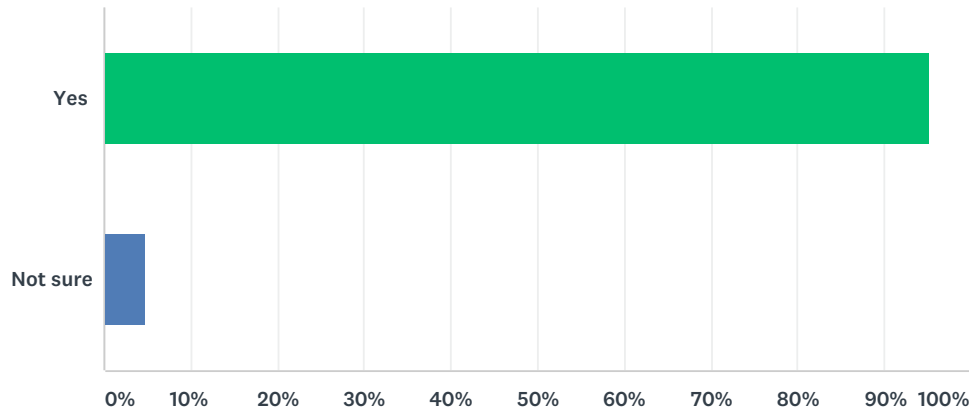

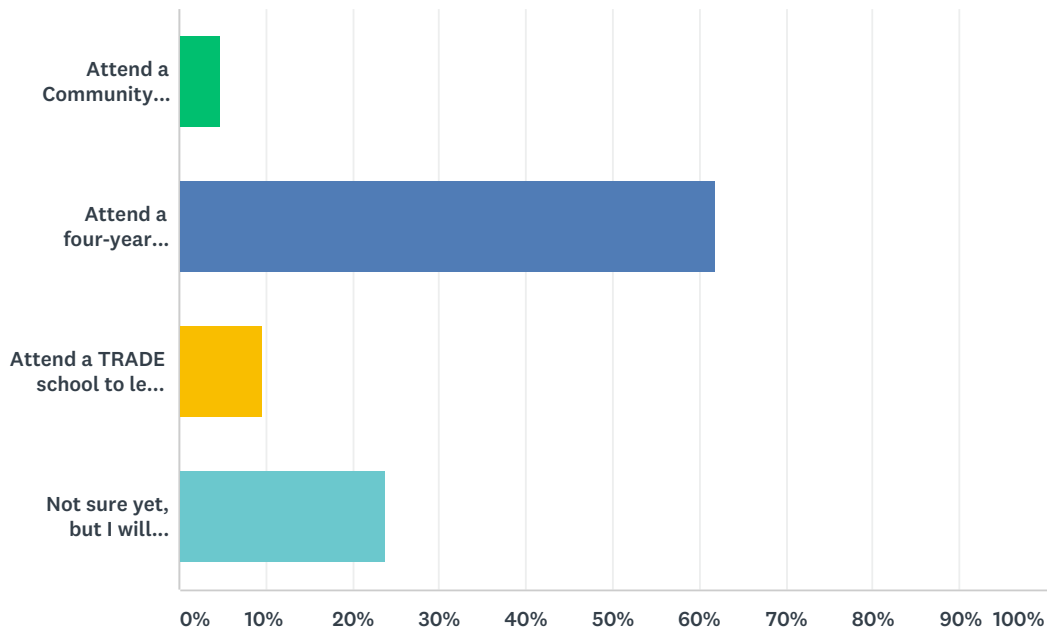

Q19 Even though it is a bit in the future, what do you plan on doing after you graduate from high school?

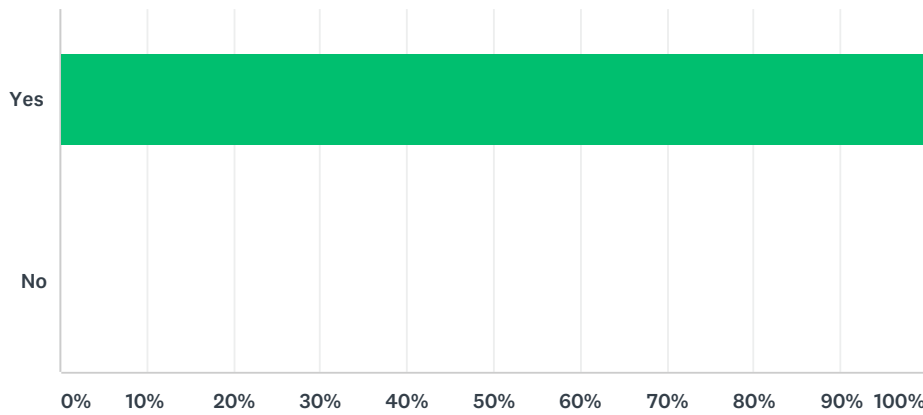

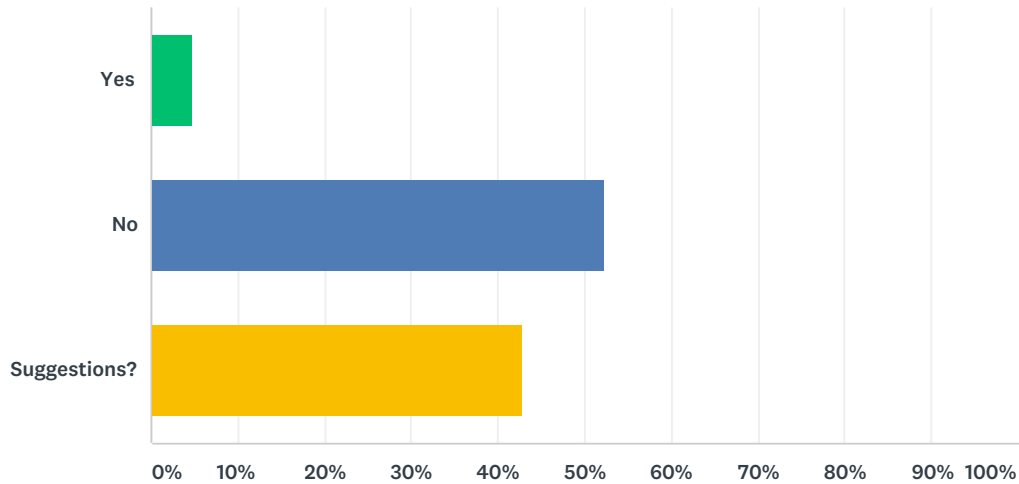
