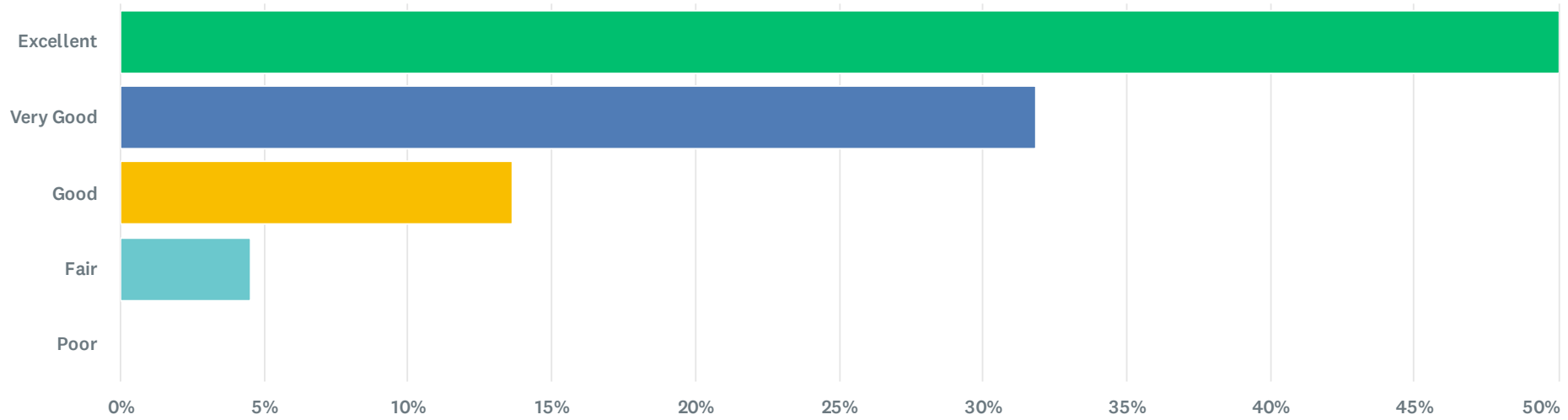


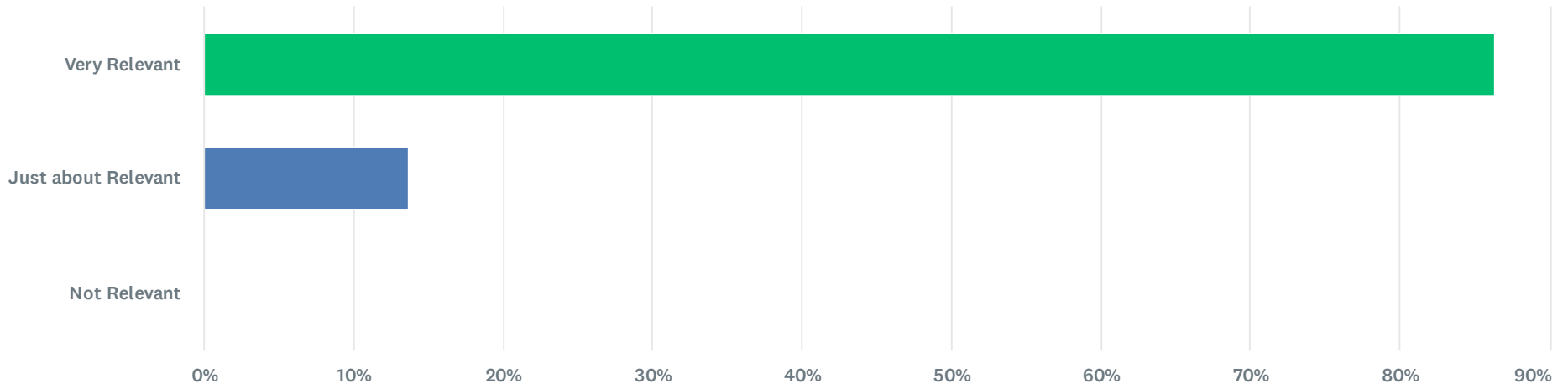

Overall, how would you rate the training on Fundamentals of Safeguarding?



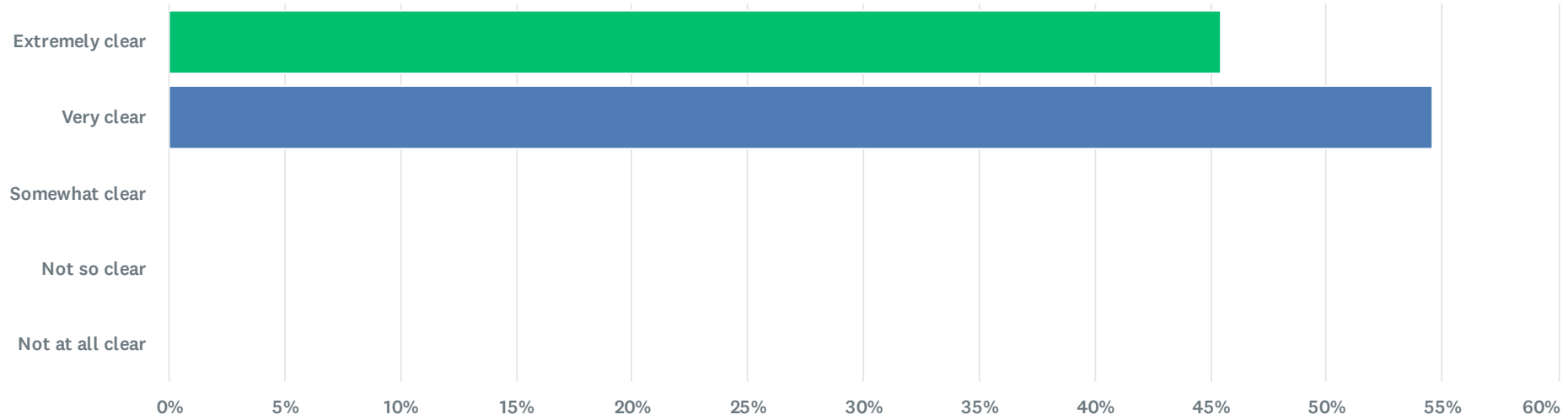

### How relevant was the training to your day-to-day work?



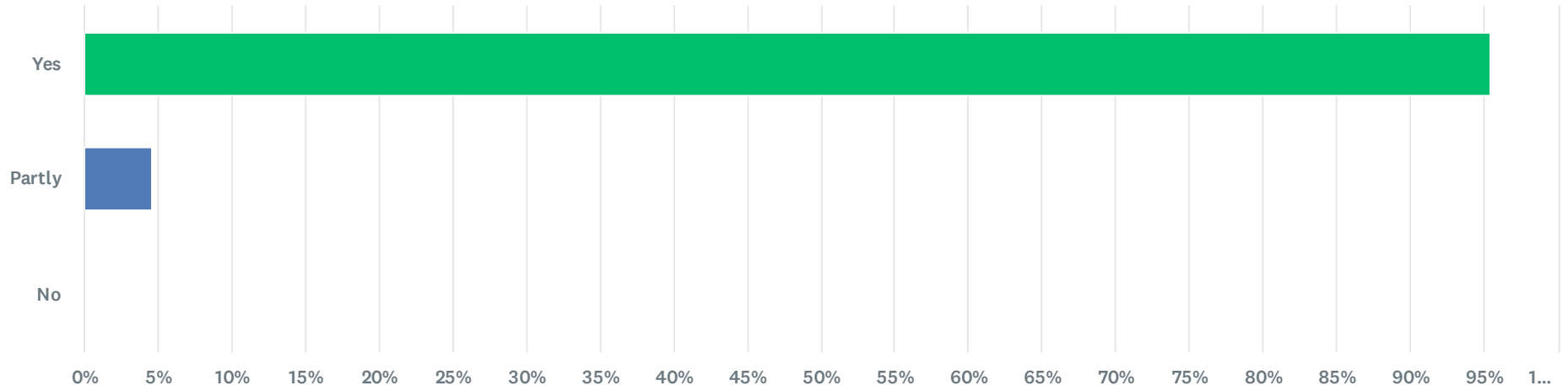

How clear and easy to follow was the content?



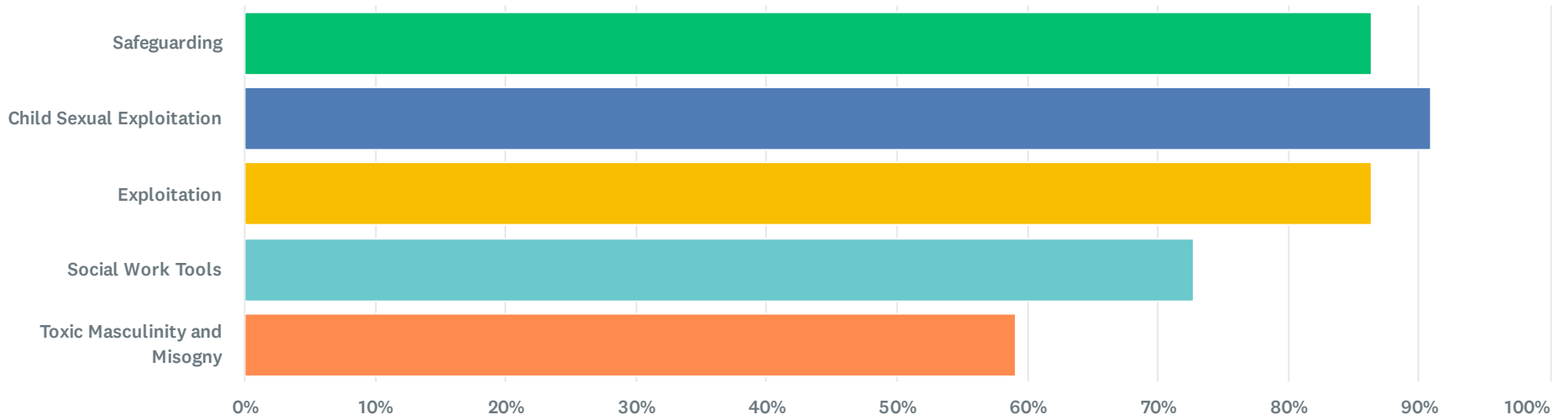

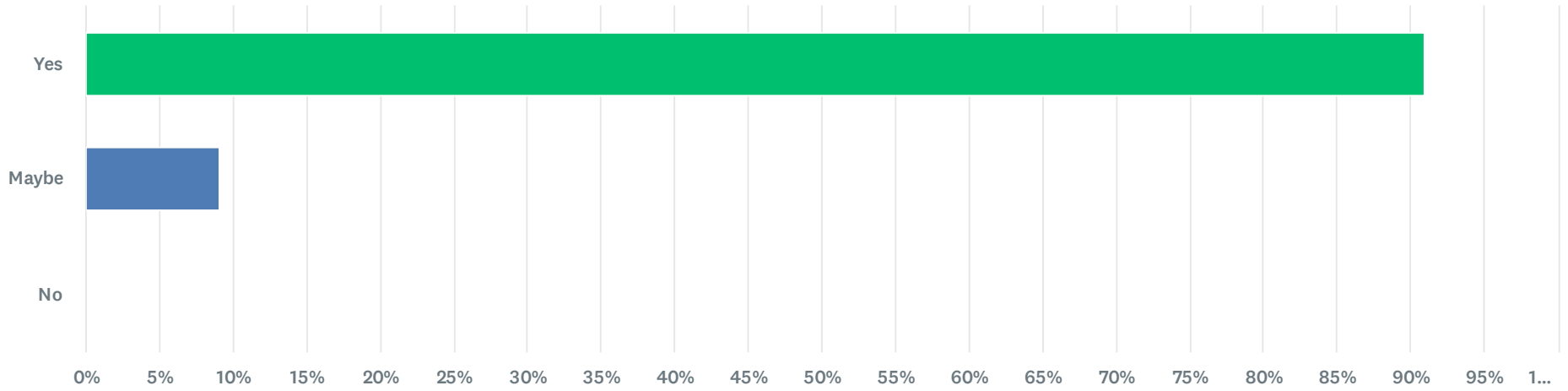
