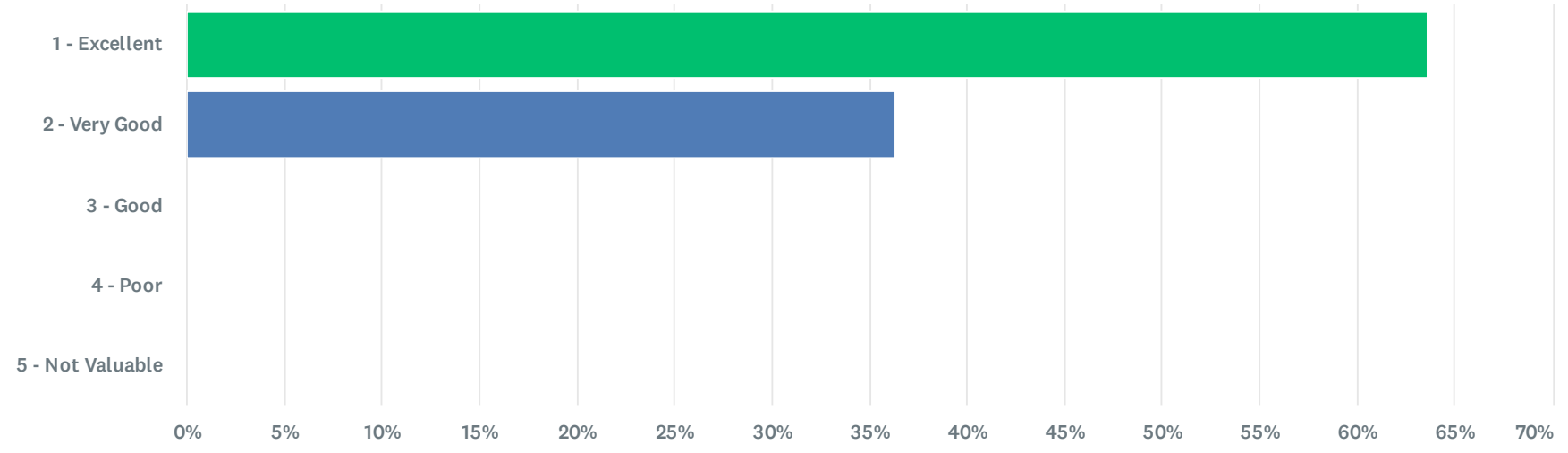

How valuable has this week's training sessions been for your role?



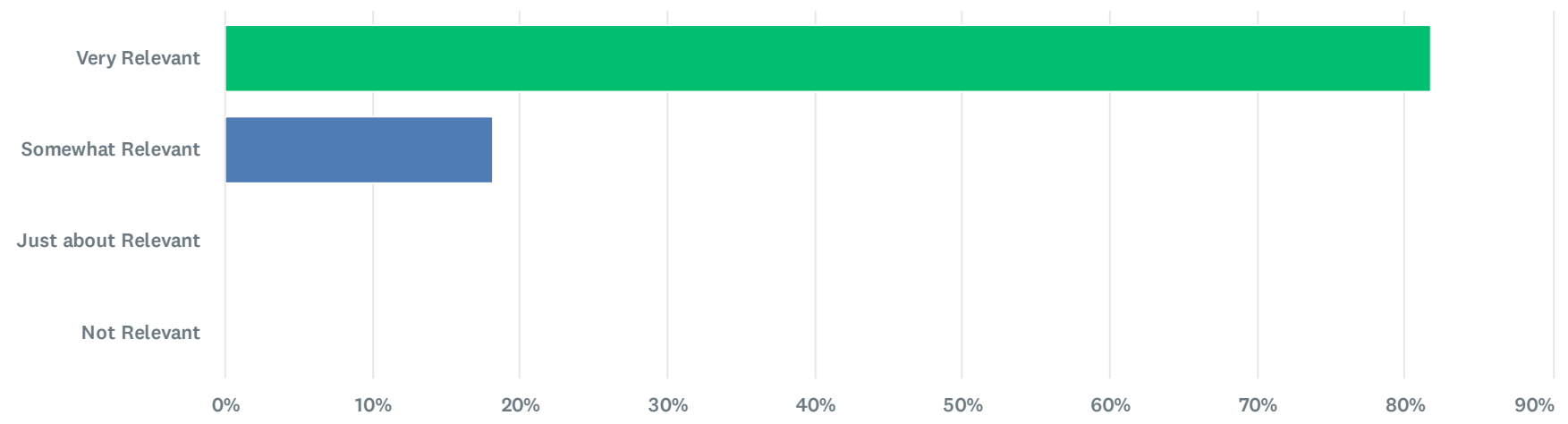

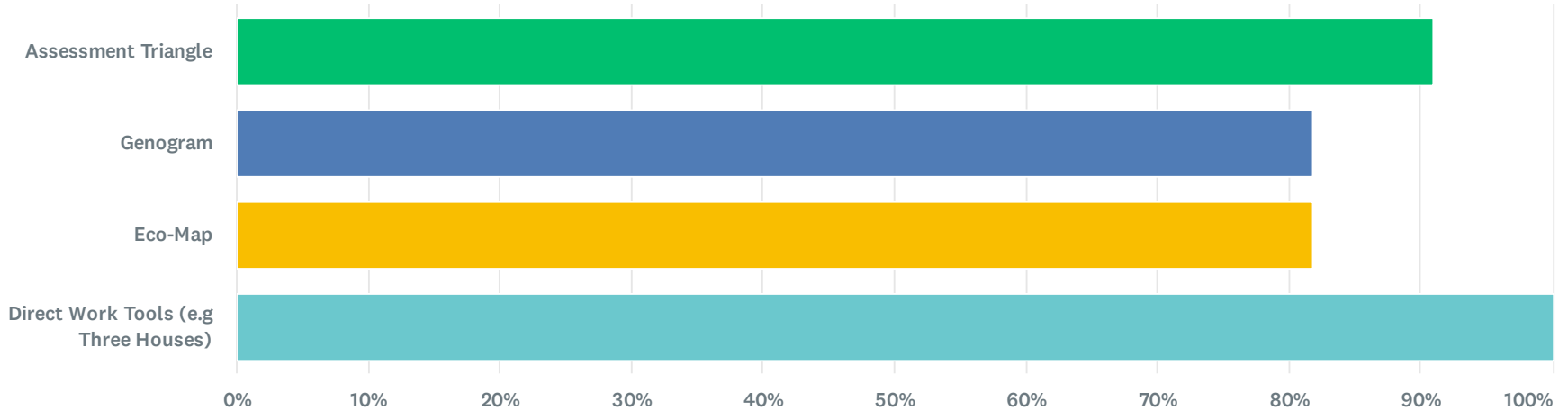

How relevant was the training content to your day-to-day work?



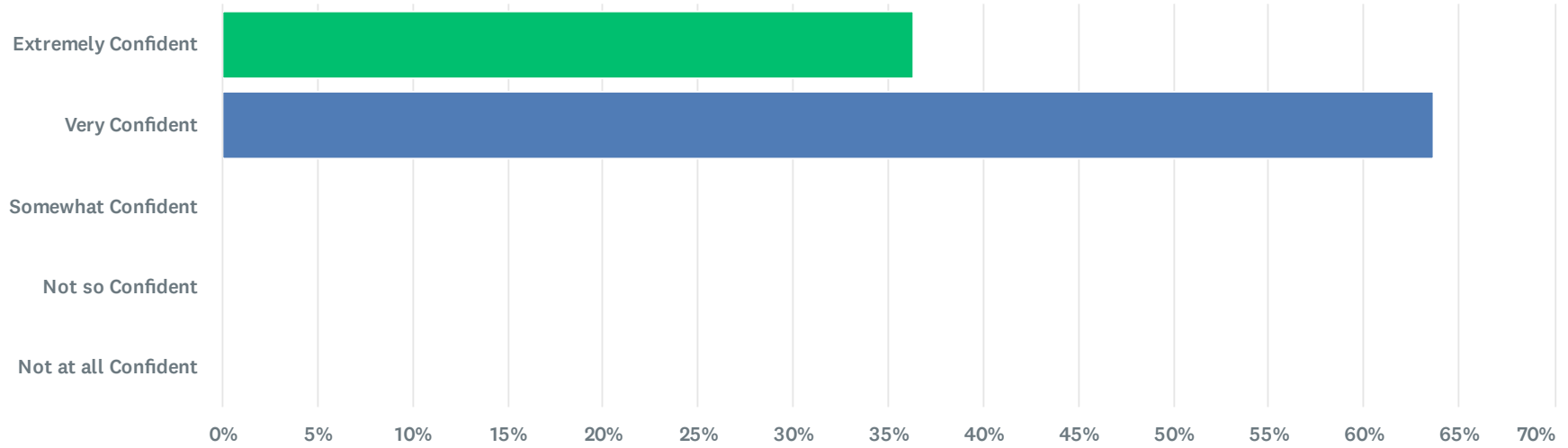
